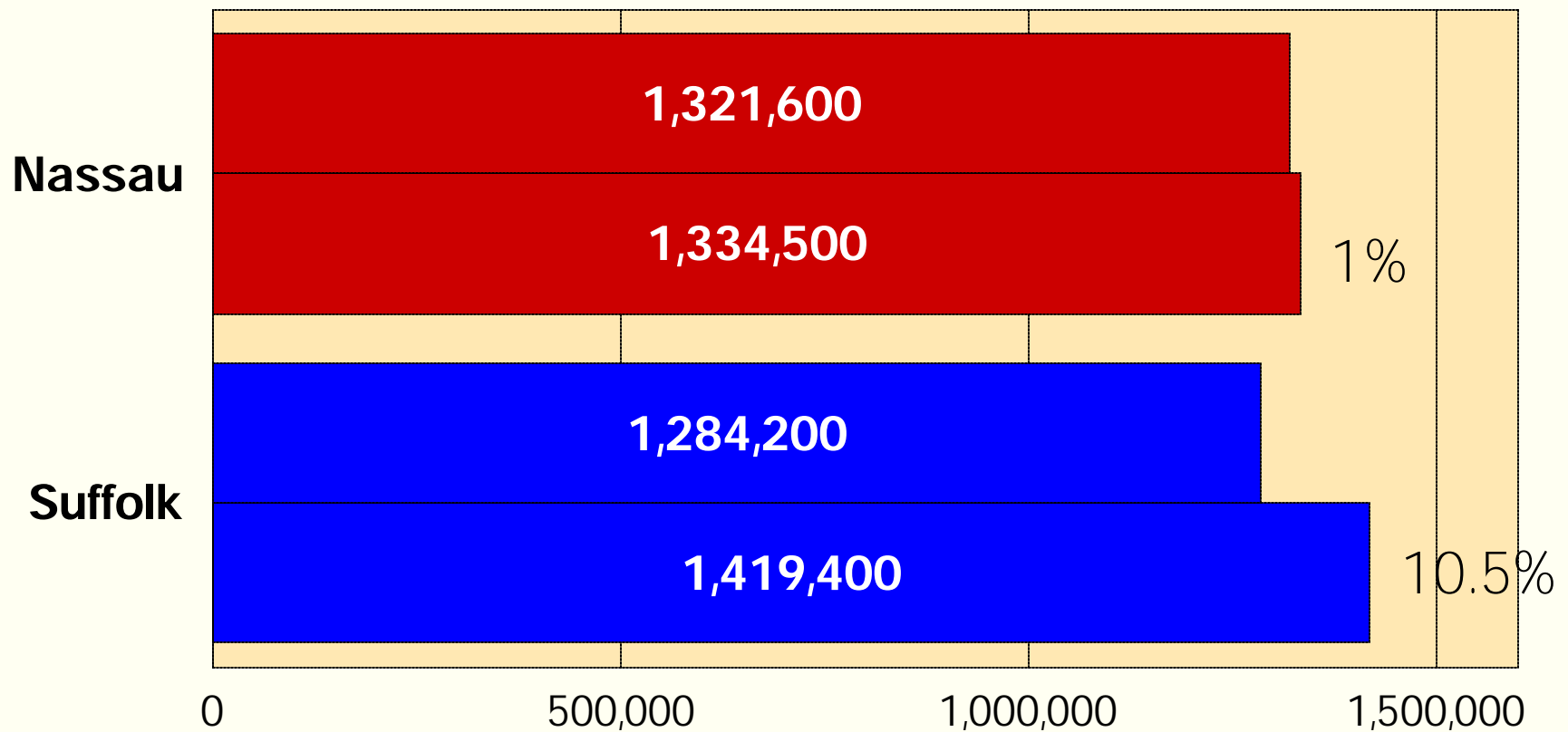

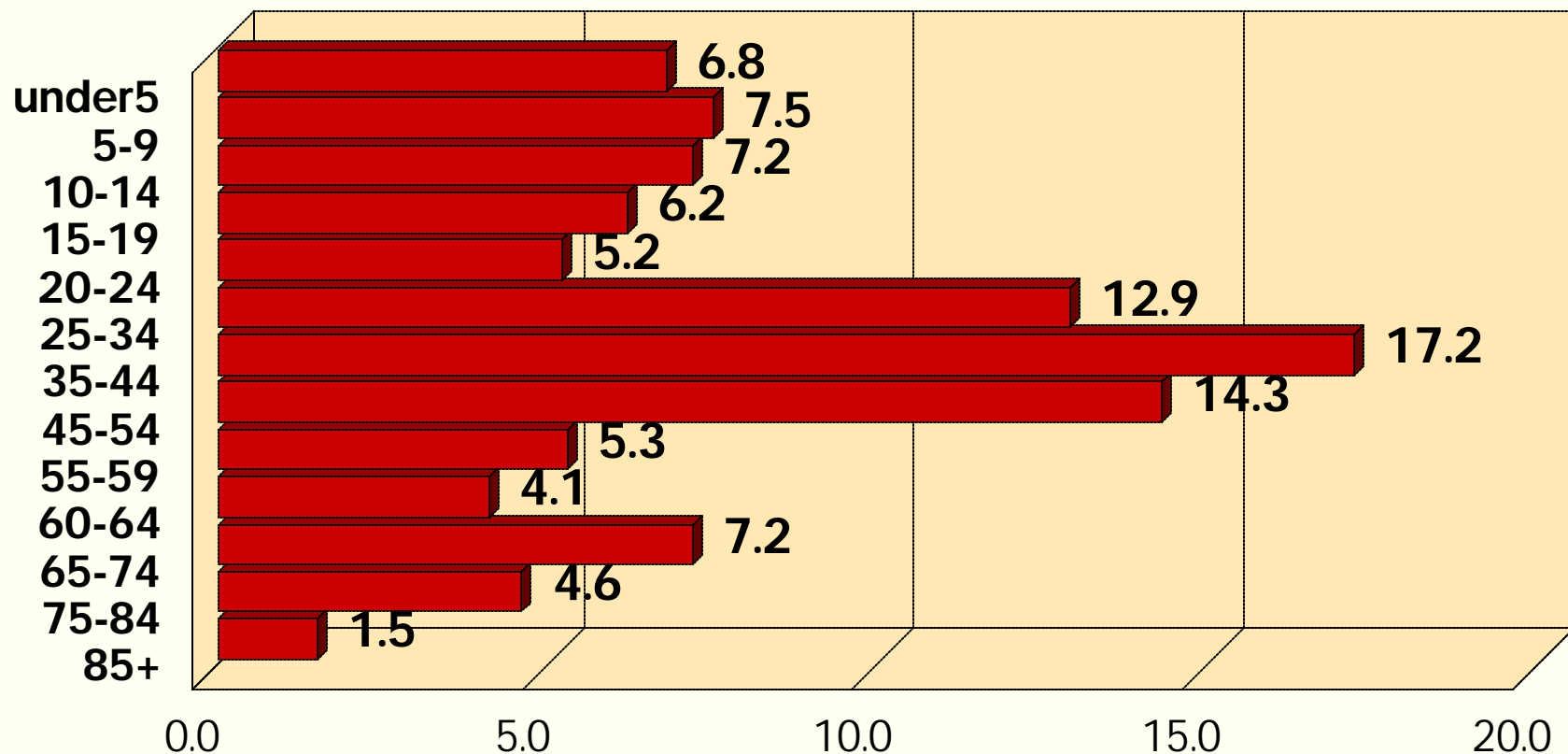

Percent Change



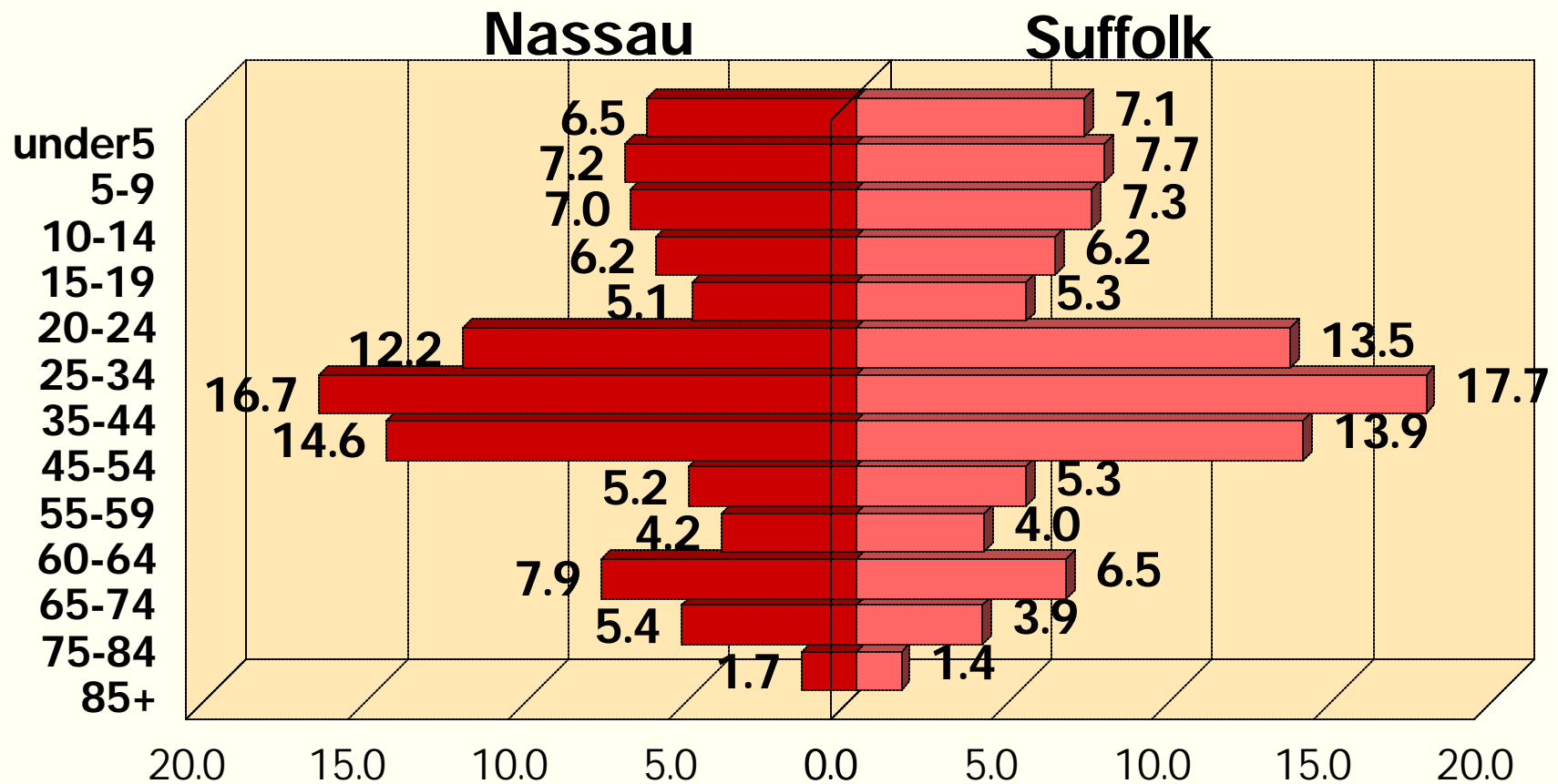
LI Population by Age

Percent Distribution



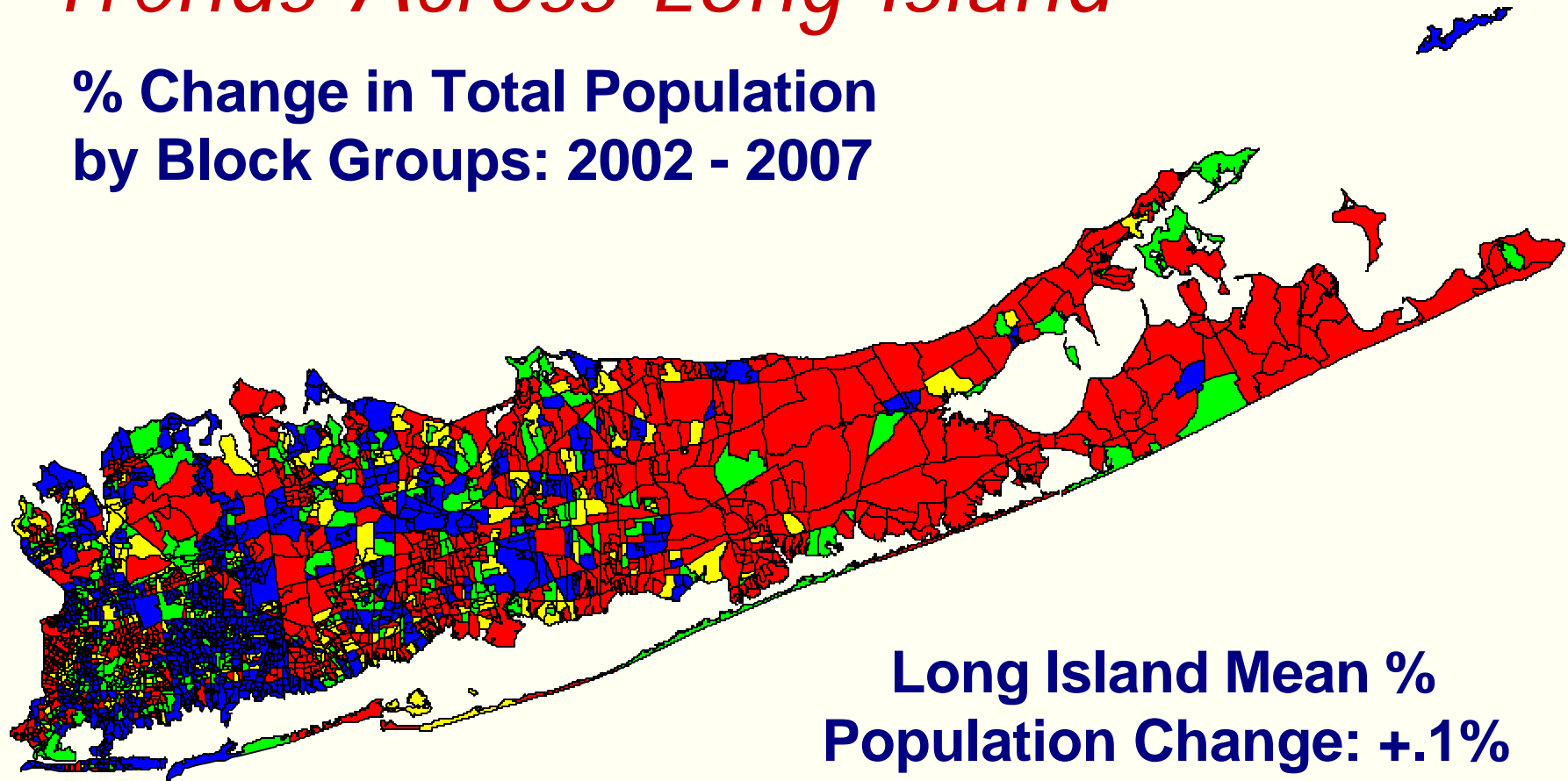

by Block Groups: 2002 - 2007**



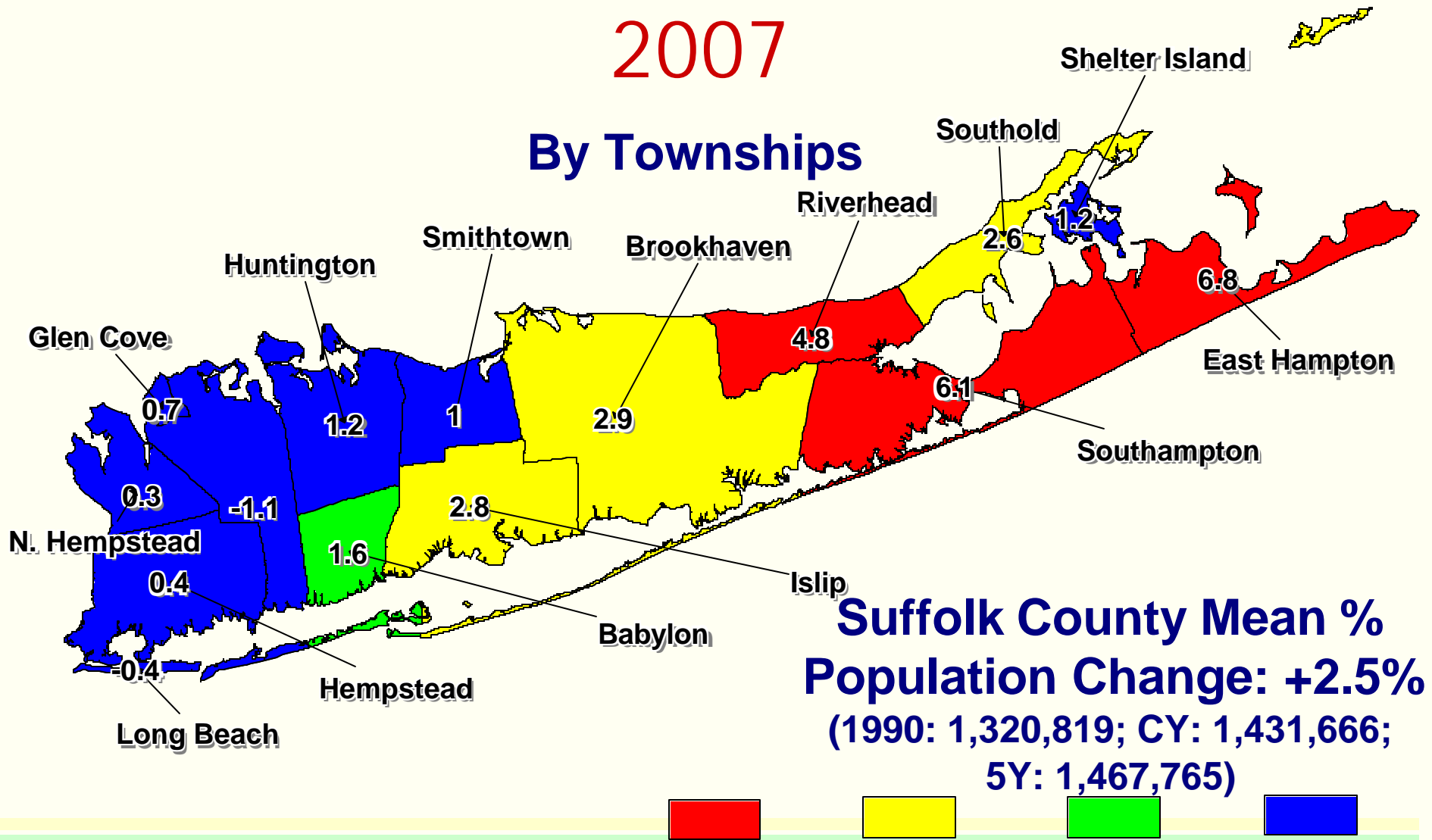

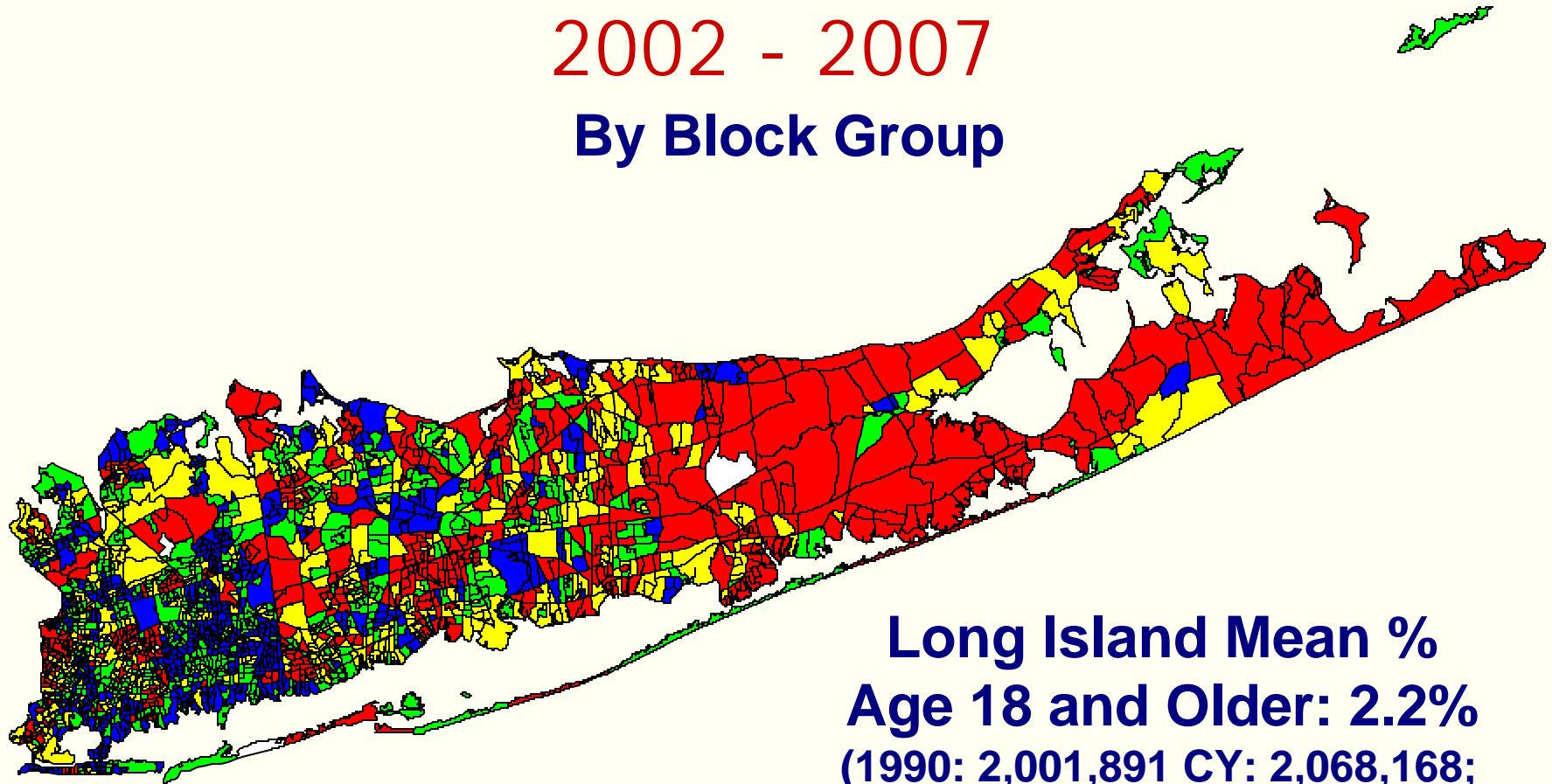

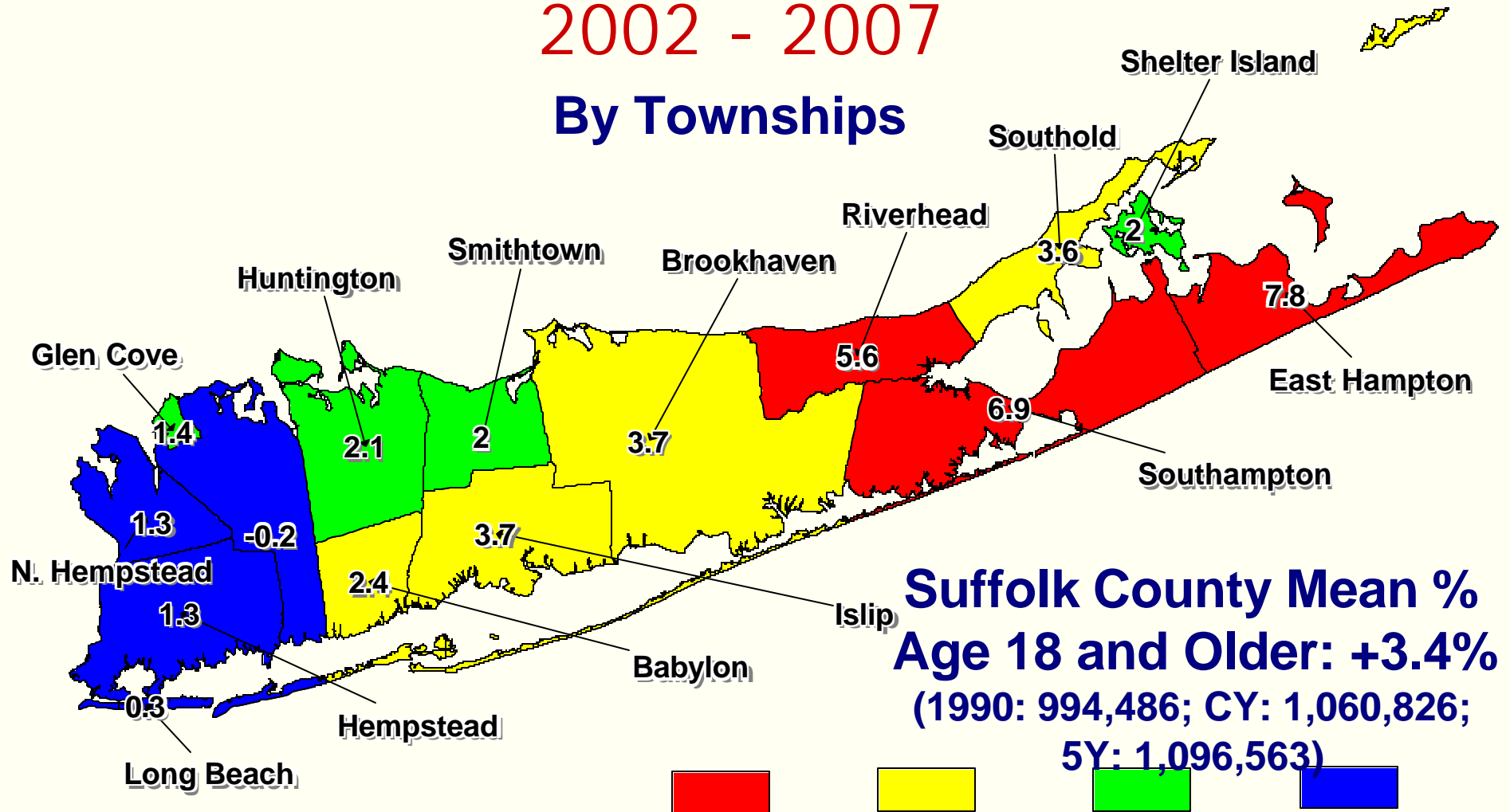

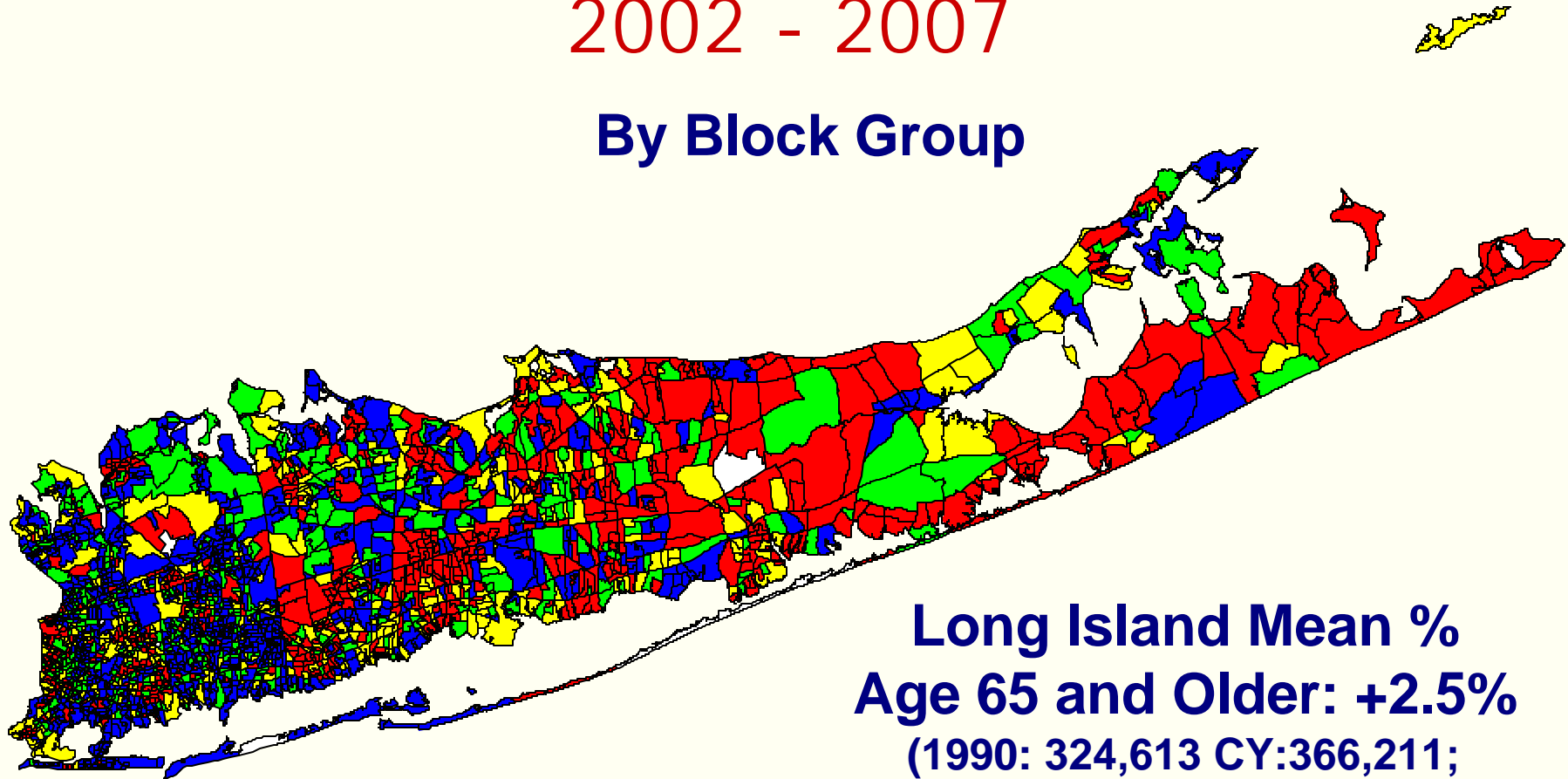

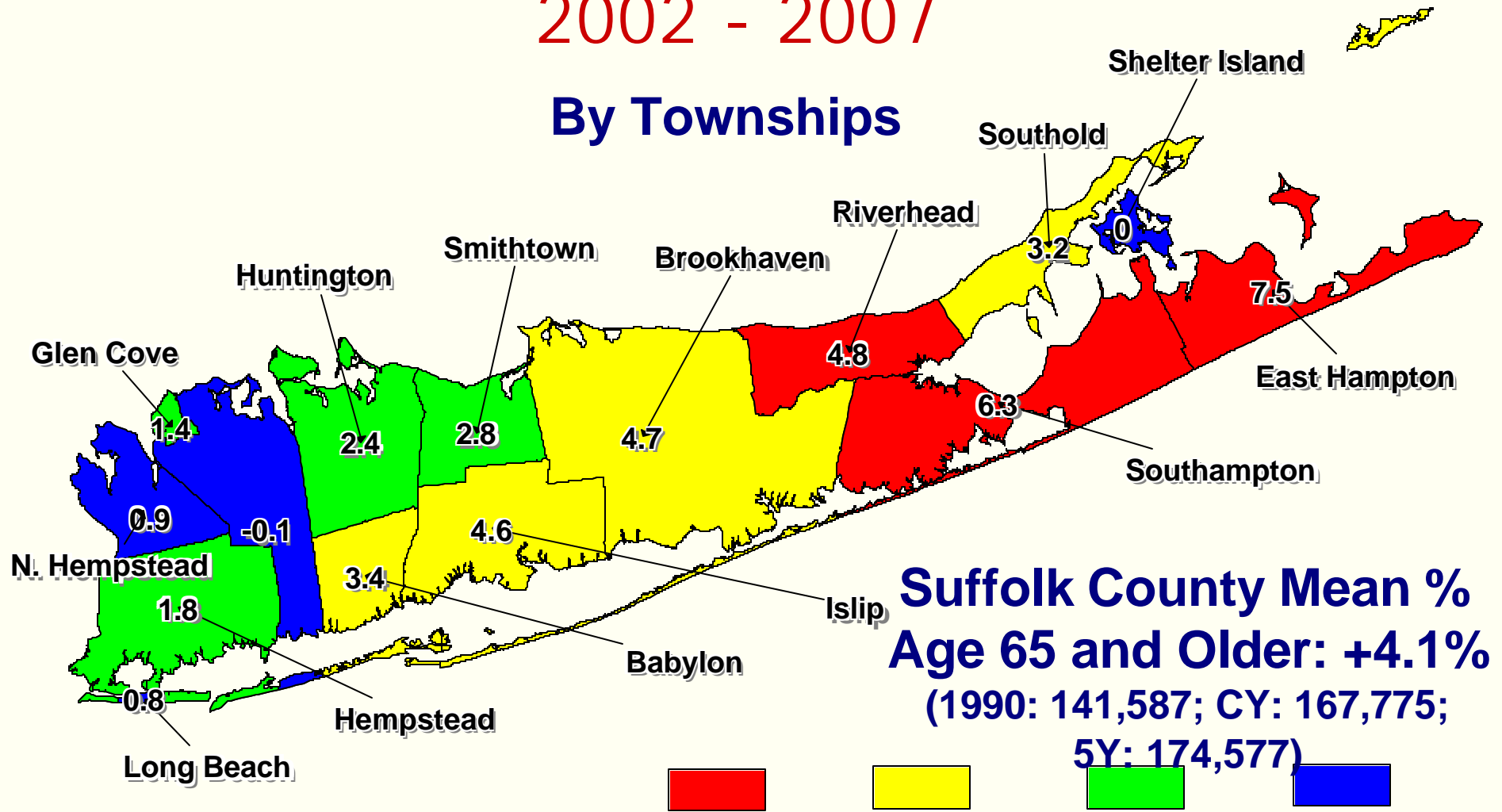

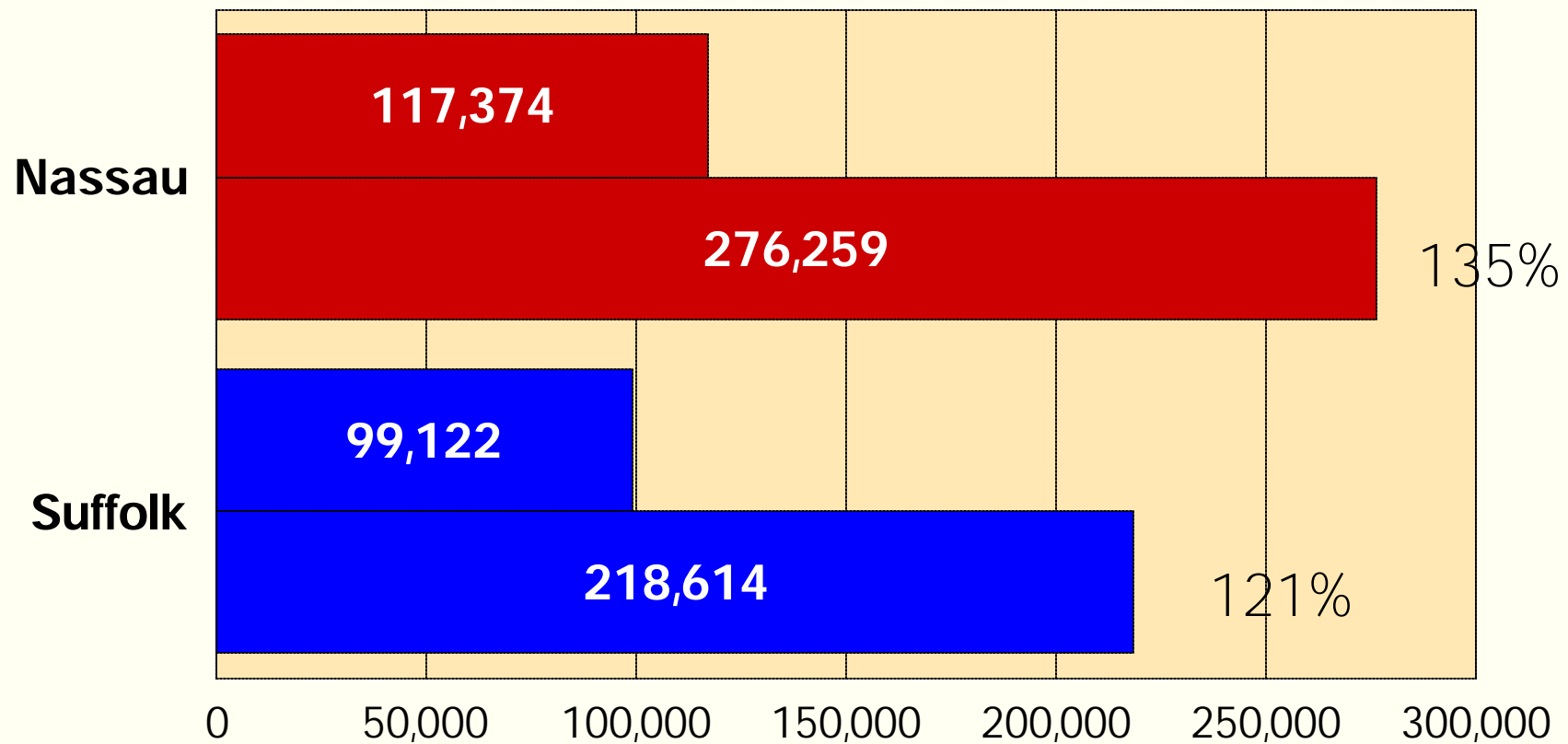

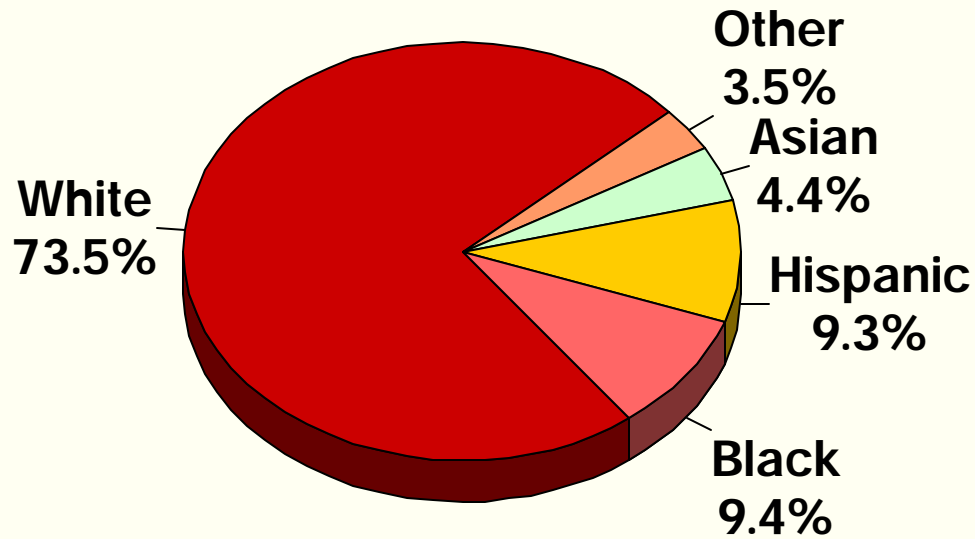

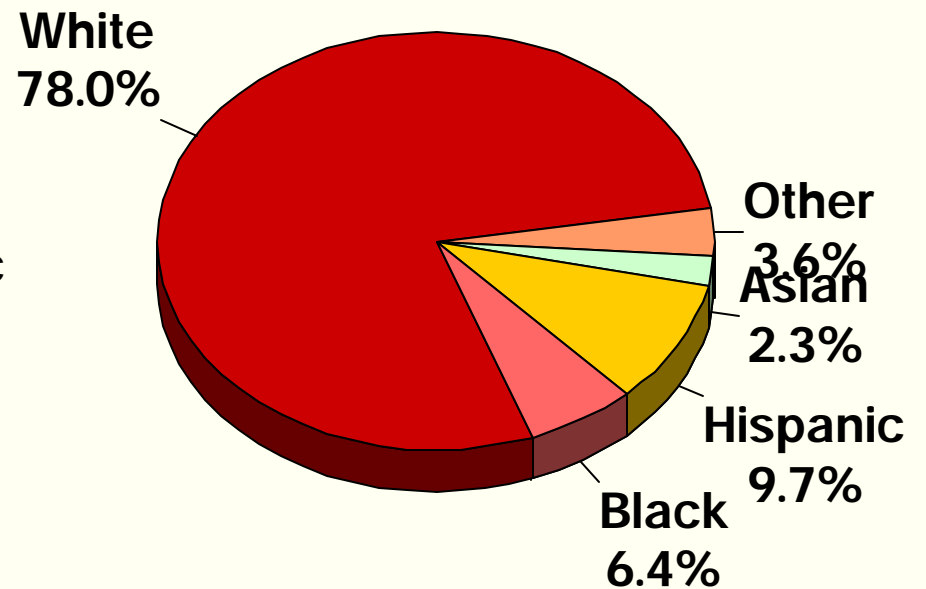
Population by Ethnicity

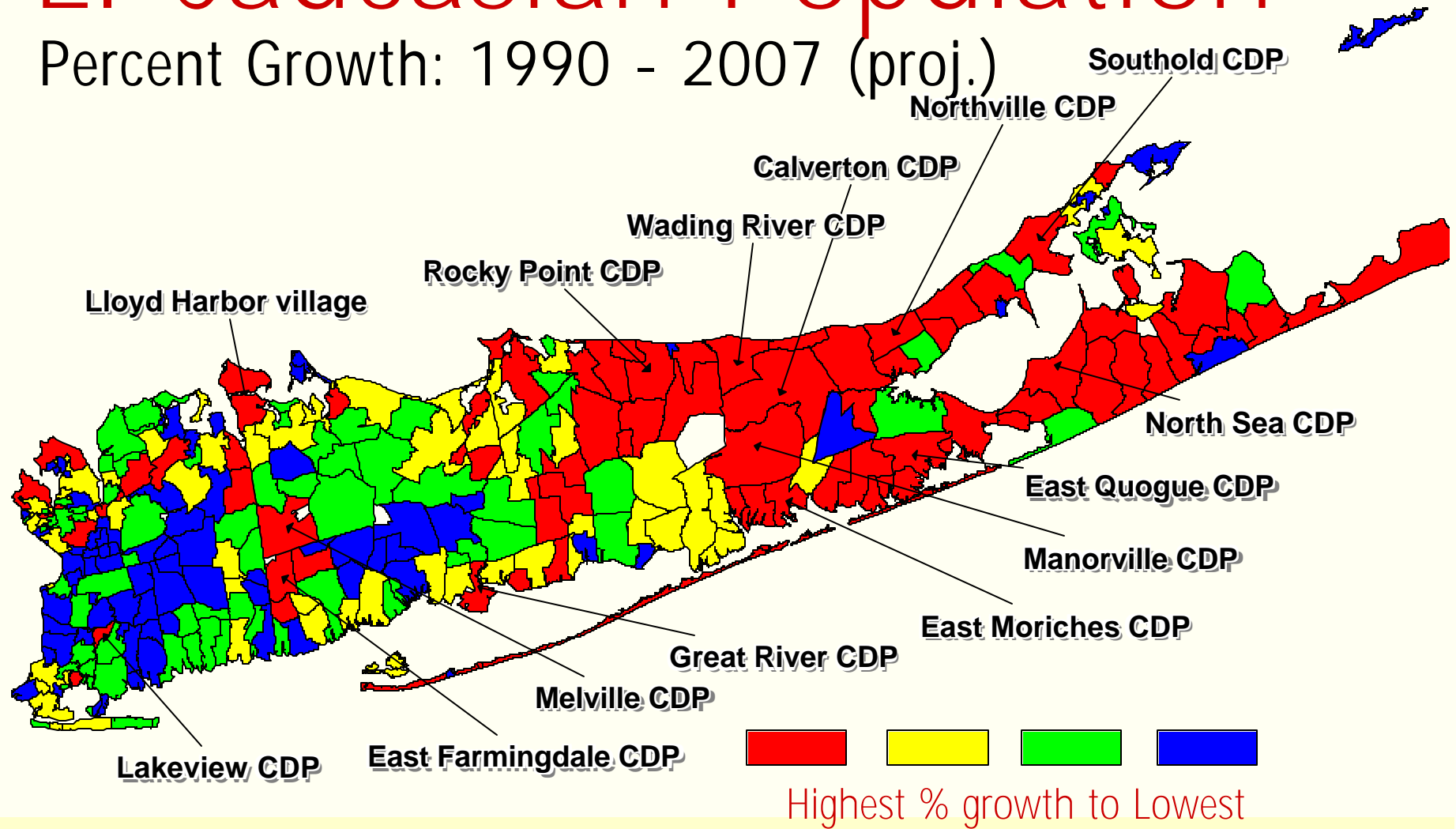

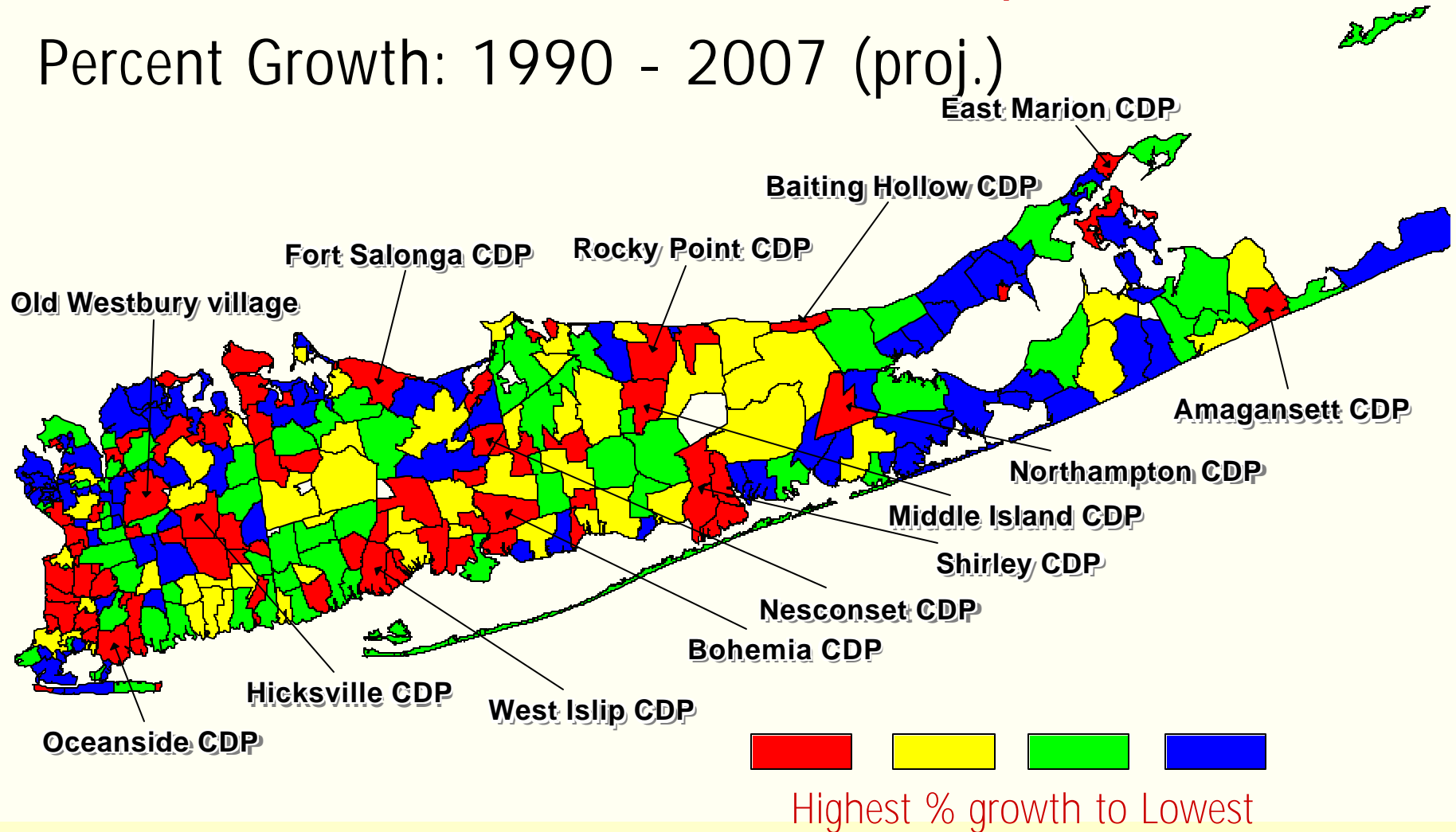
LI Caucasian Population

Percent Growth: 1990 - 2007 (proj.)



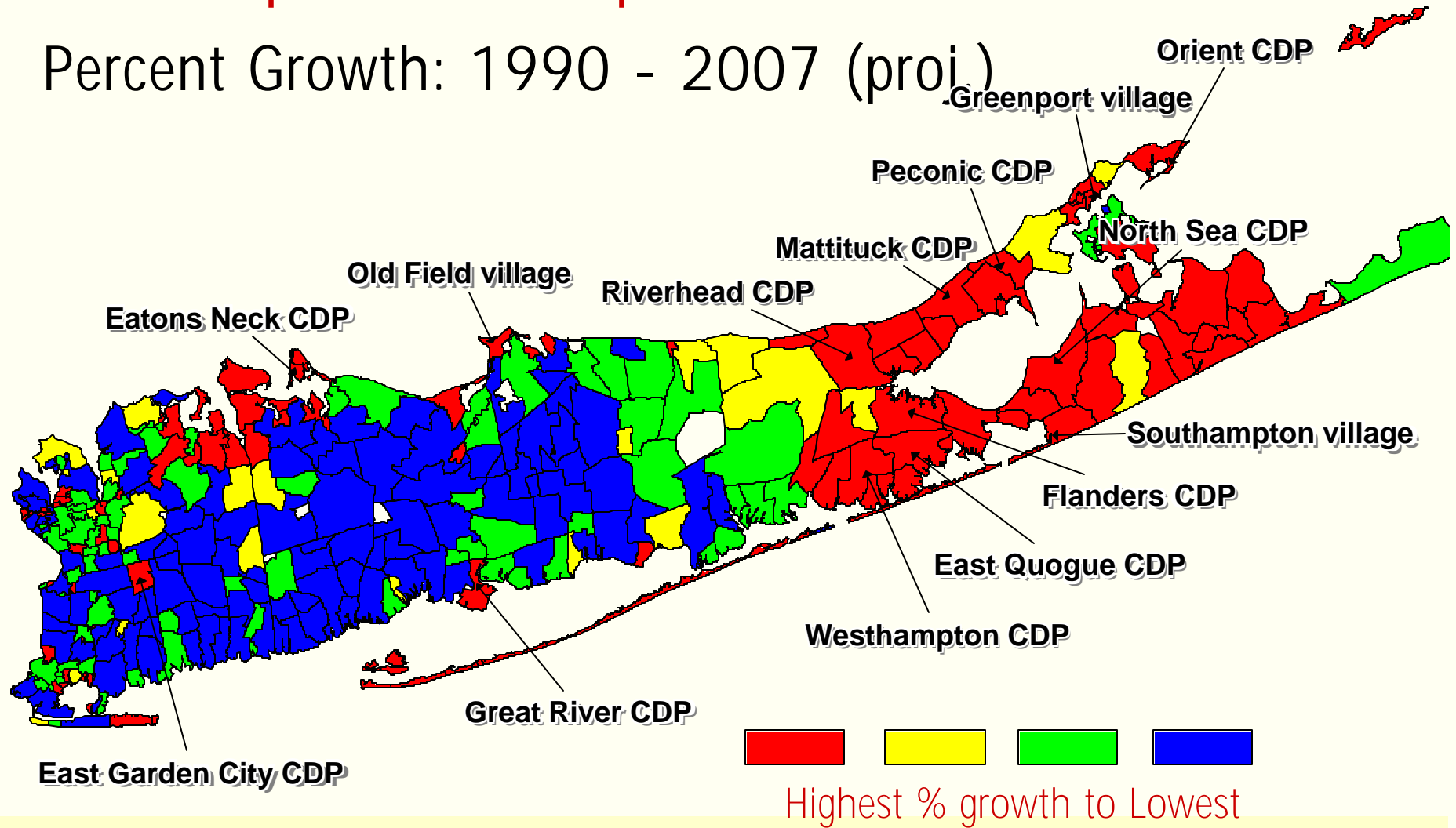
LI African-American Population

Percent Growth: 1990 - 2007 (proj.)



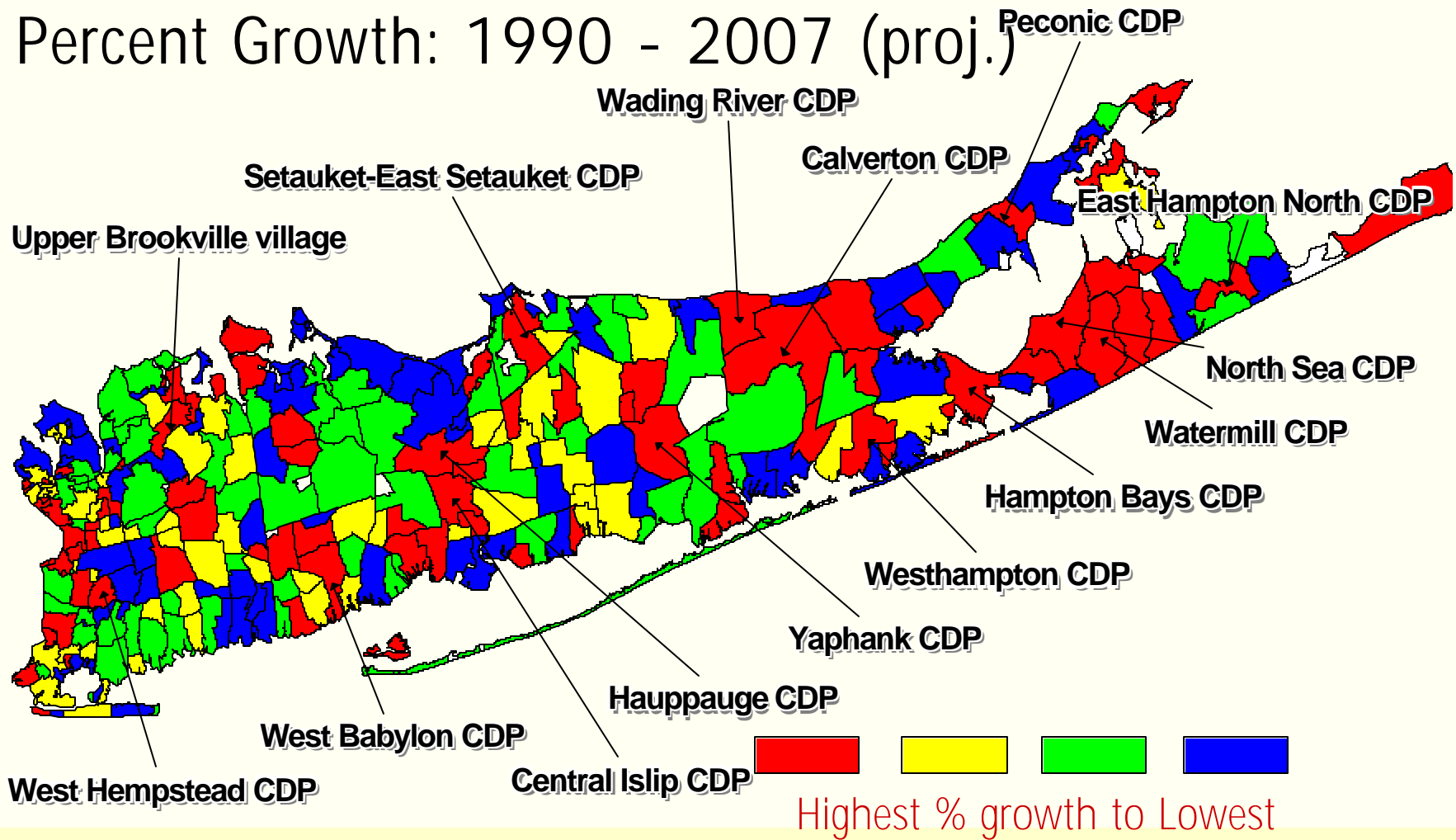
LI Hispanic Population

Percent Growth: 1990 - 2007 (proj.)



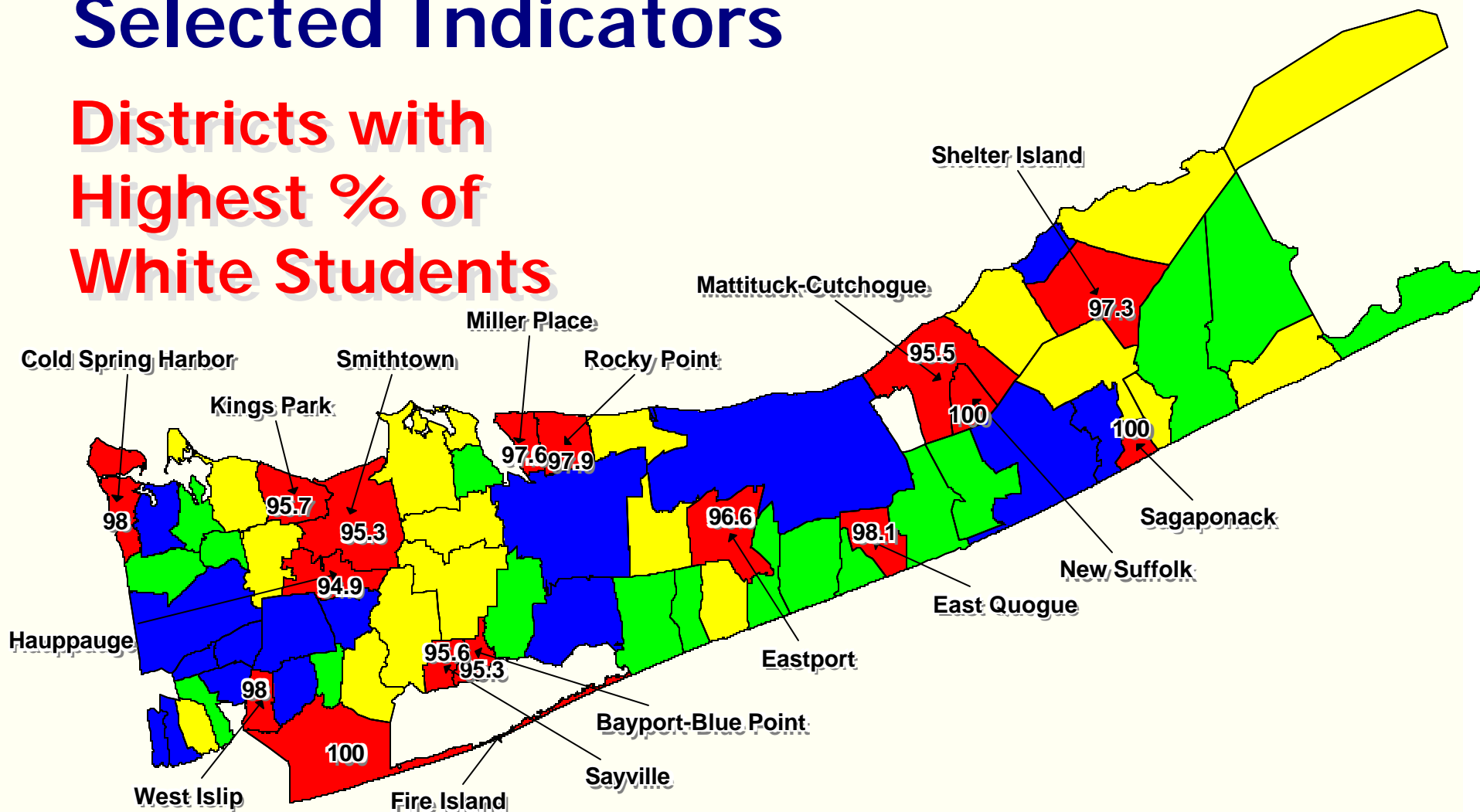
LI Asian Population

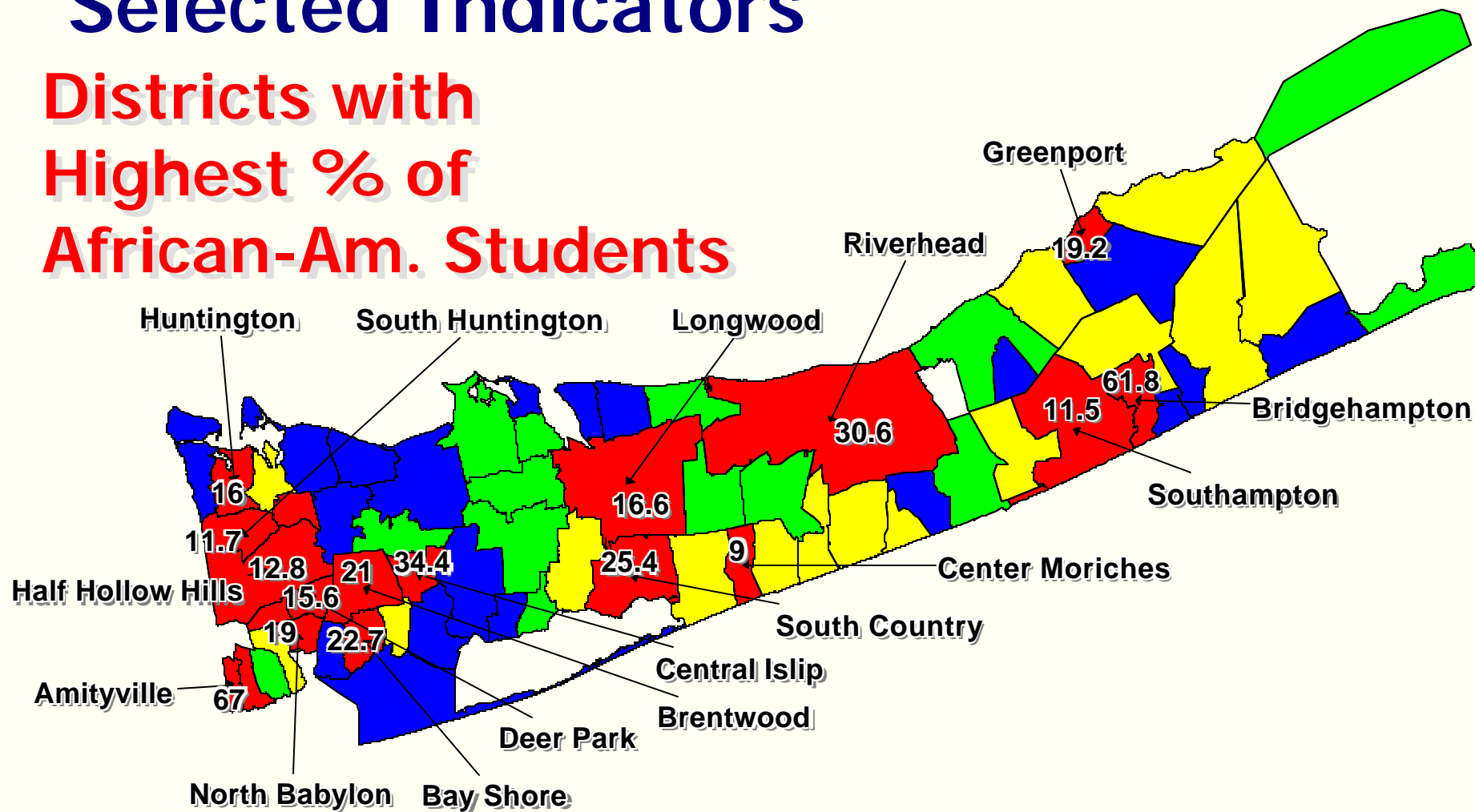
Districts with Highest % of White Students

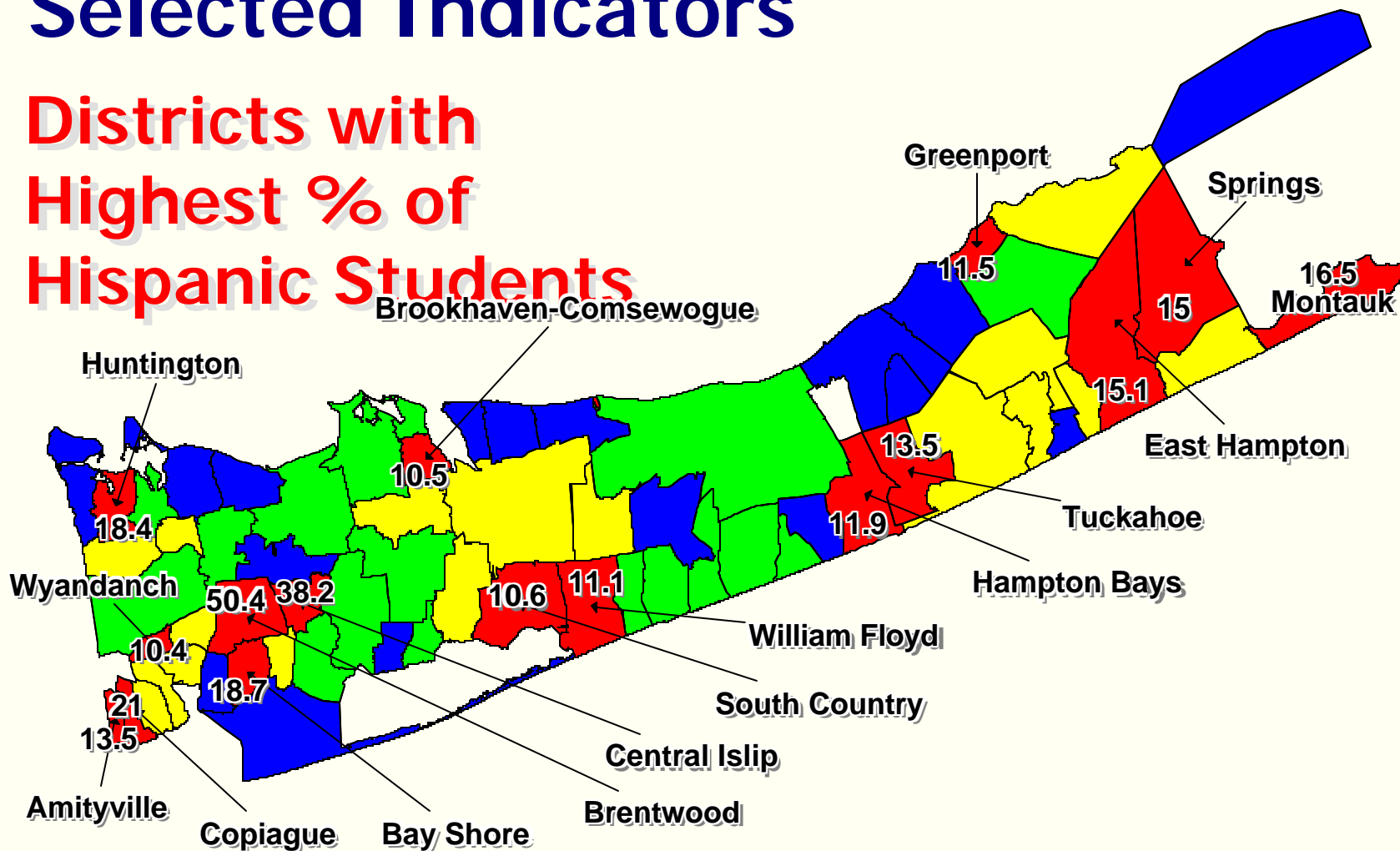

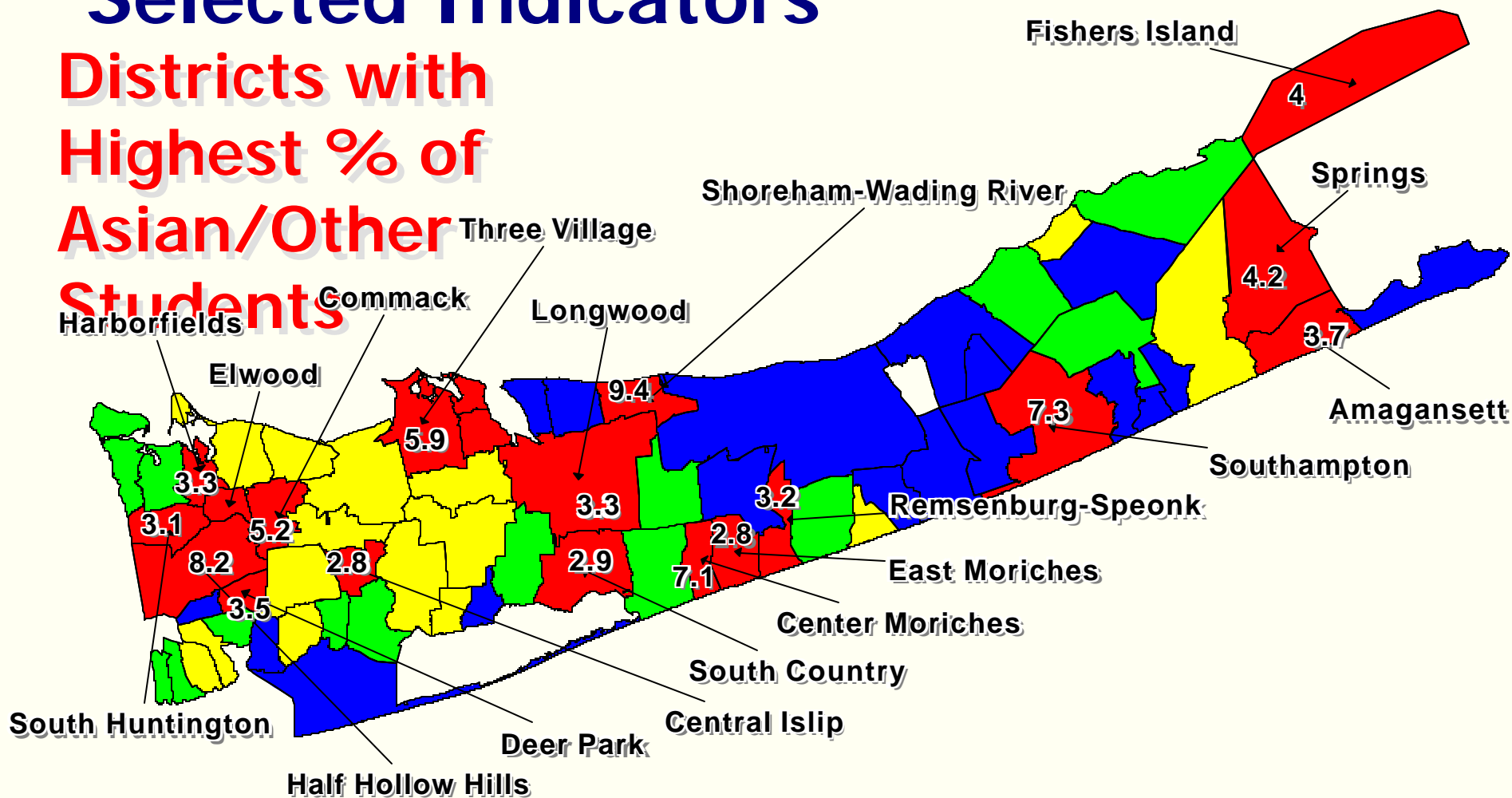

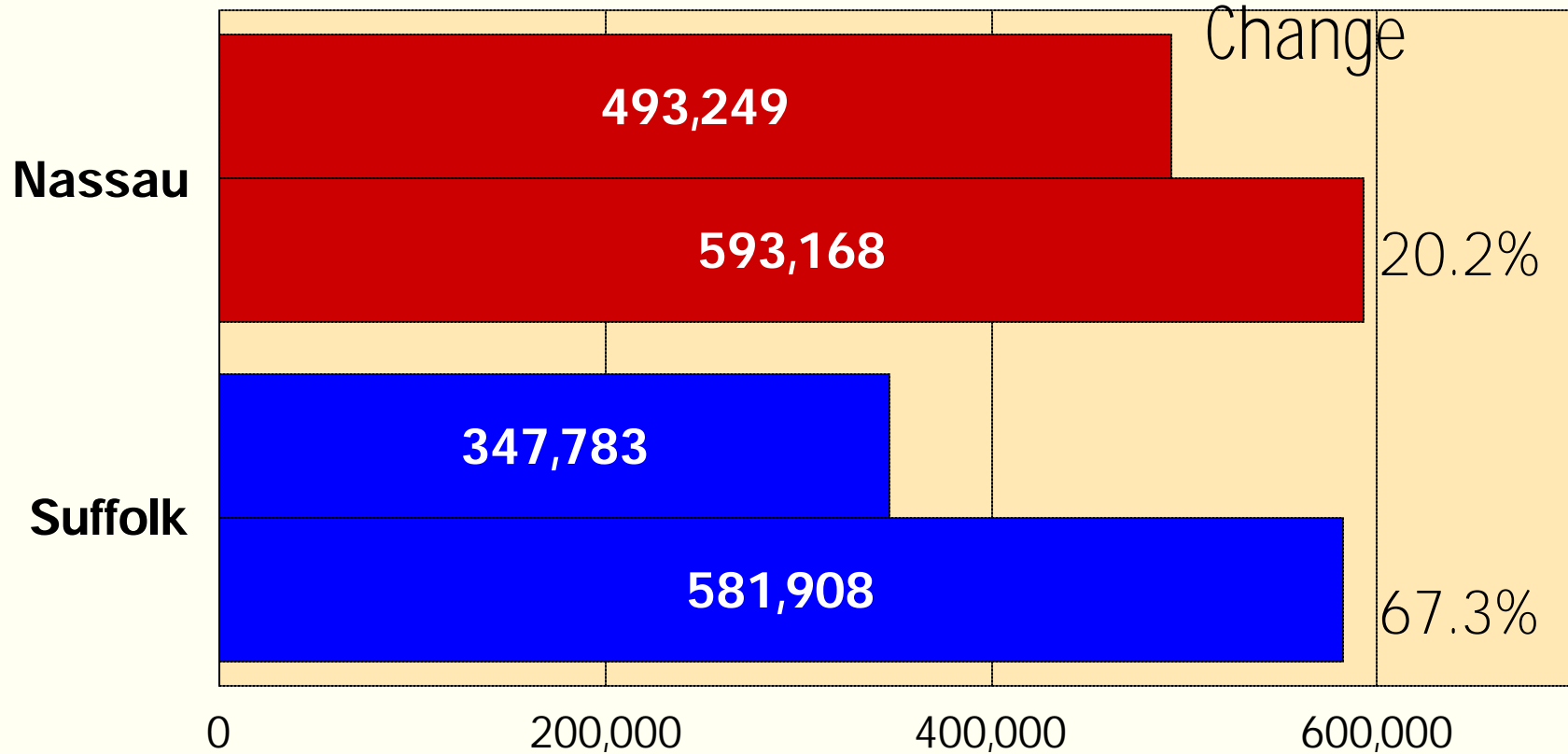

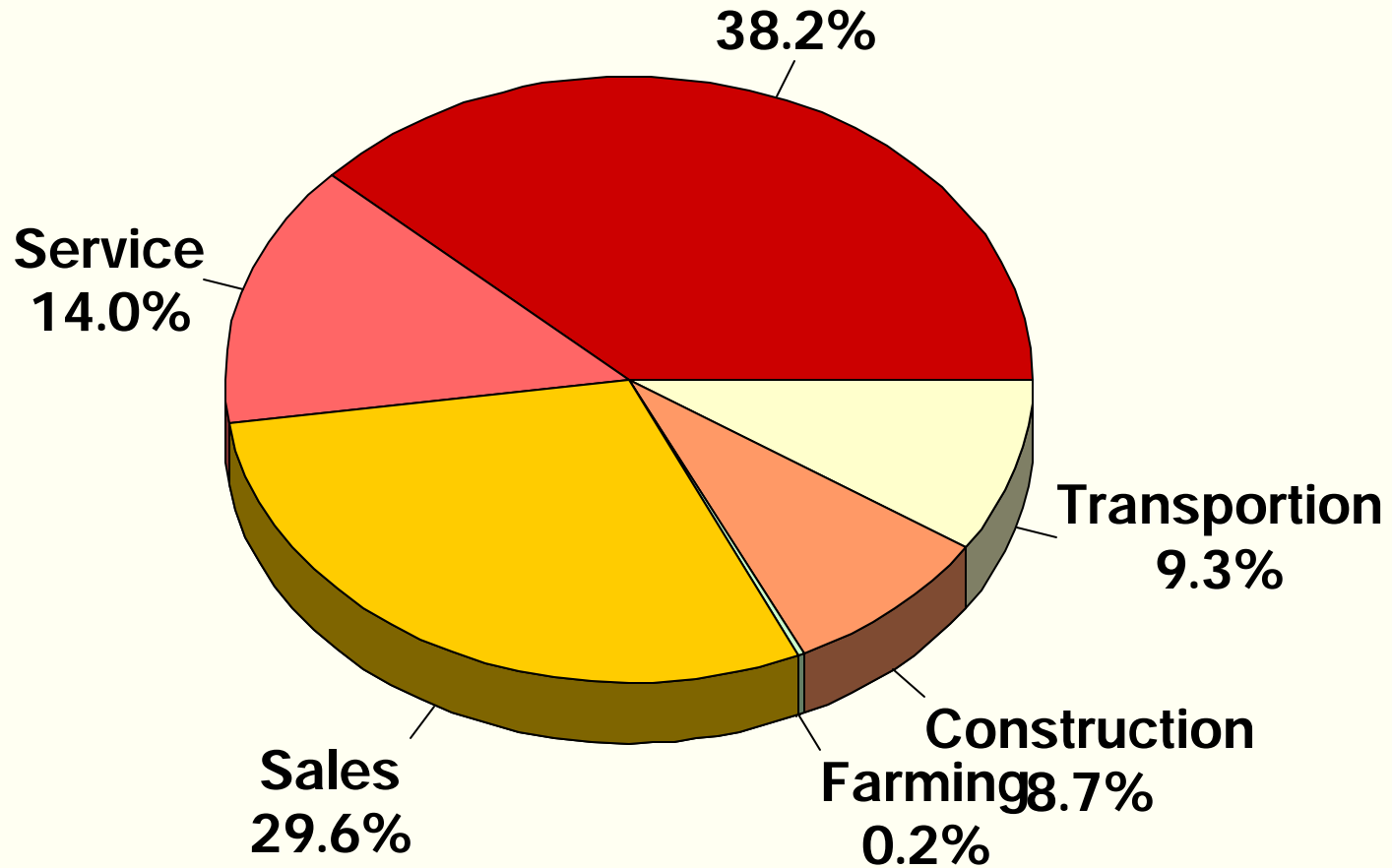

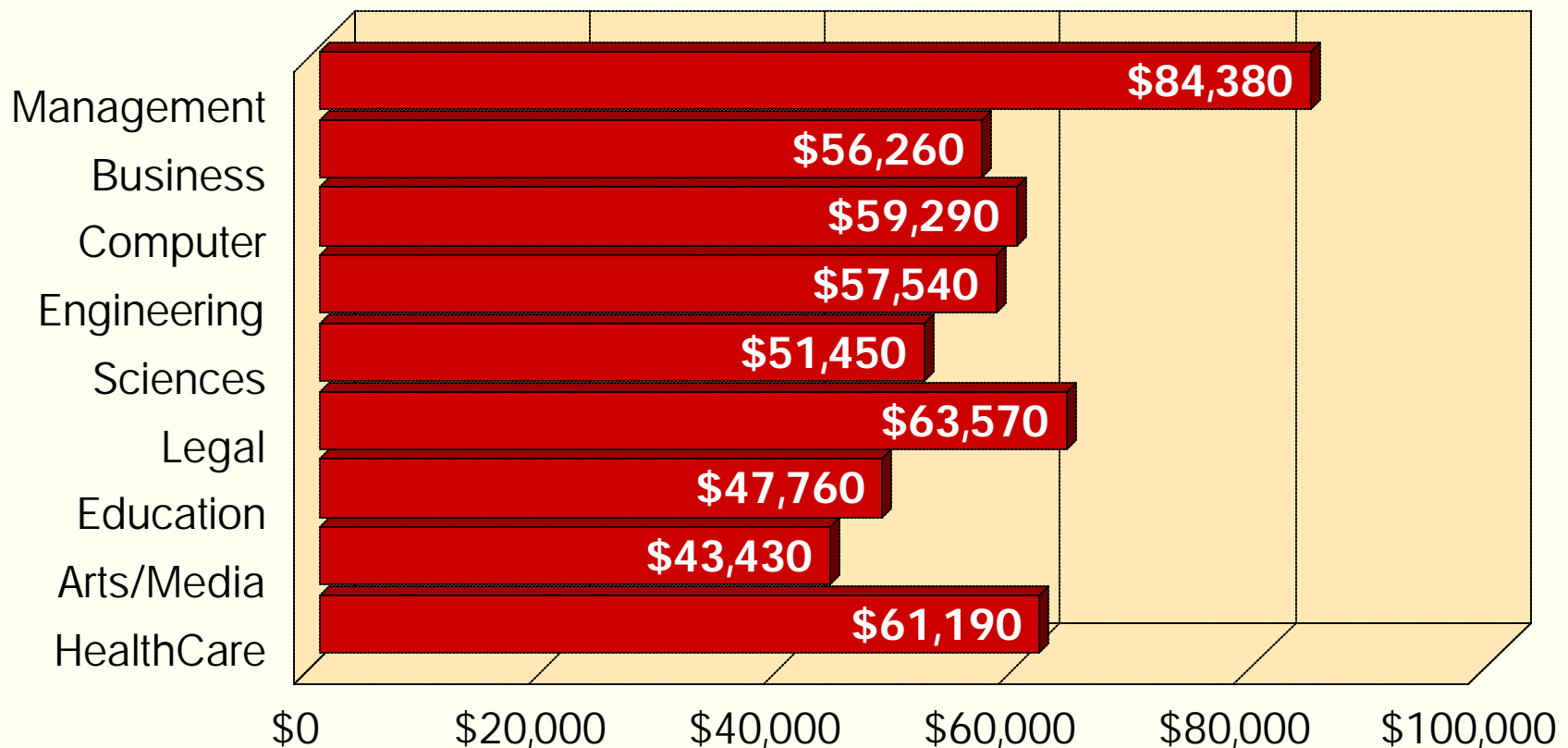
LI Job Occupations

Percent Distribution: 2002 Management



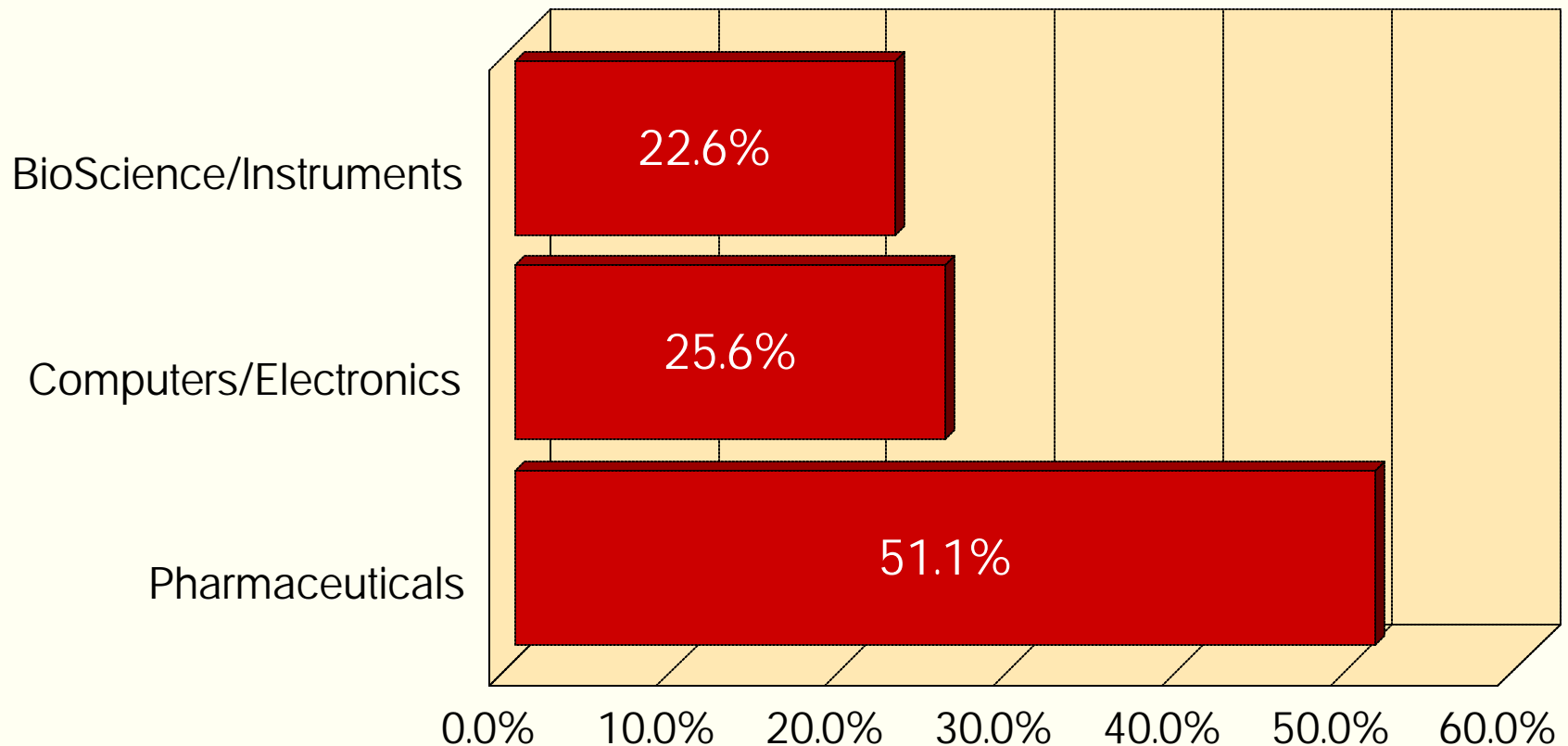
Annual Average Wages

By Occupation (2002)



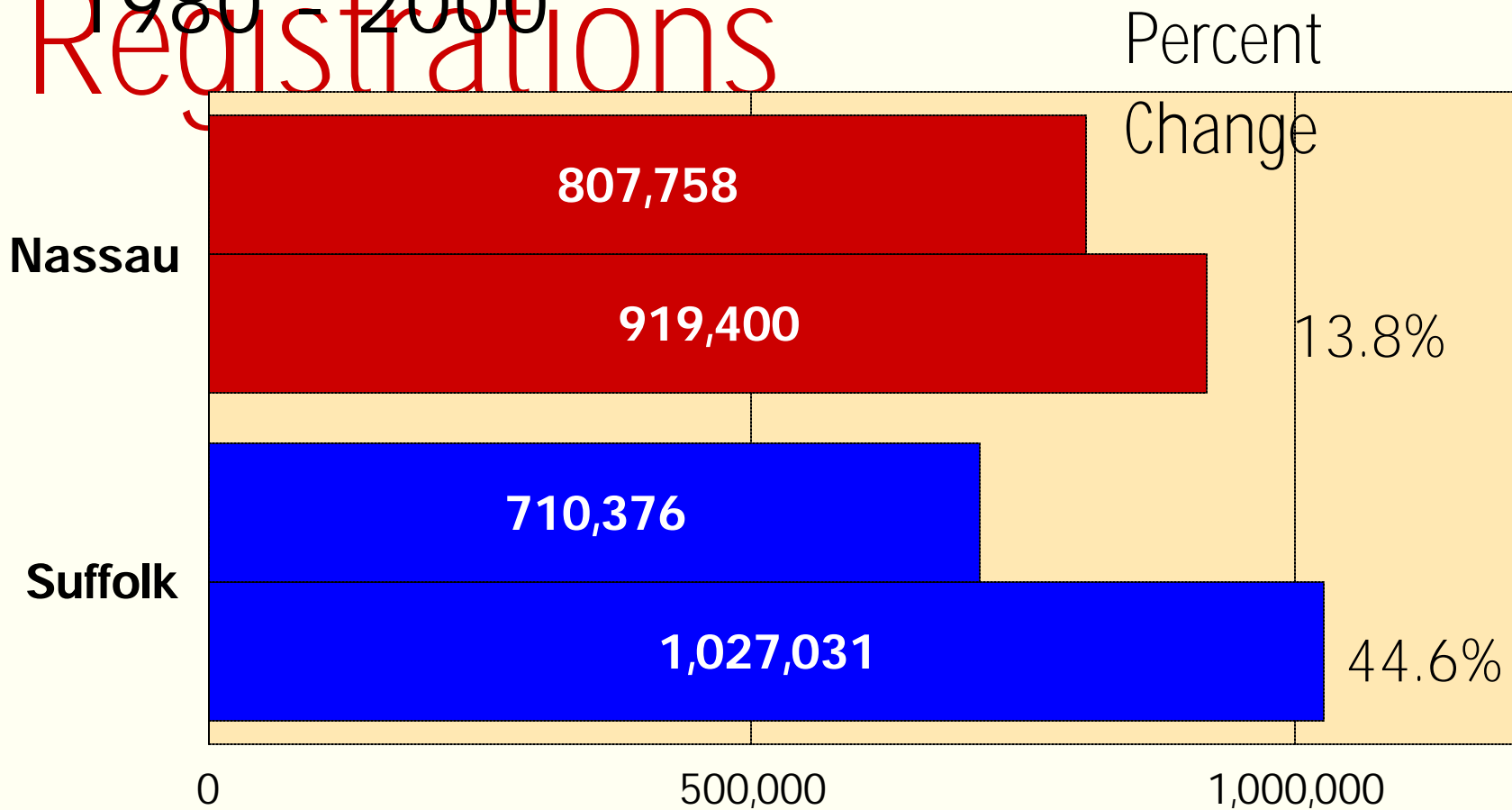
LI Global Market Exports

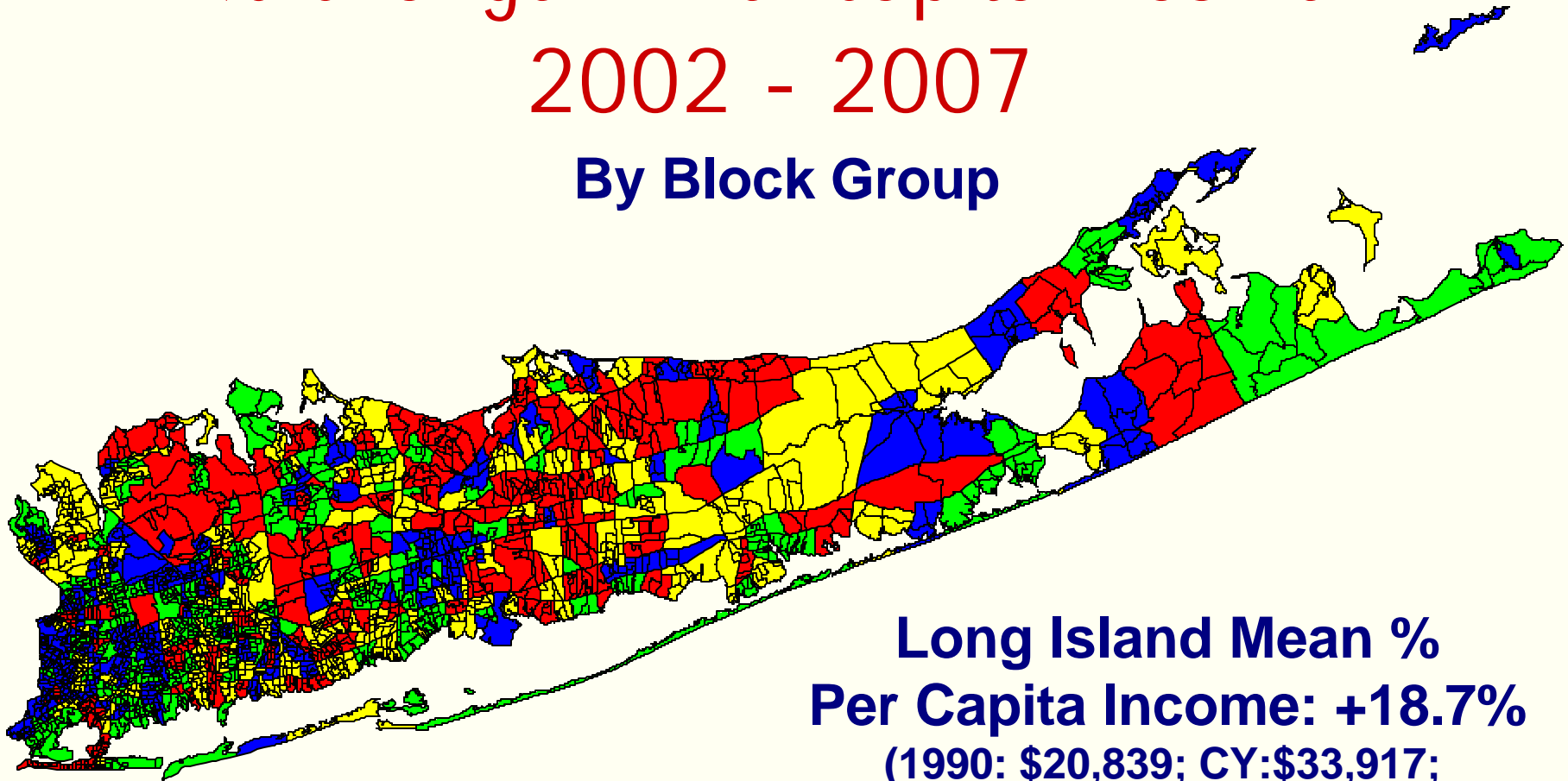

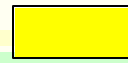


**% Change in Per Capita Income:

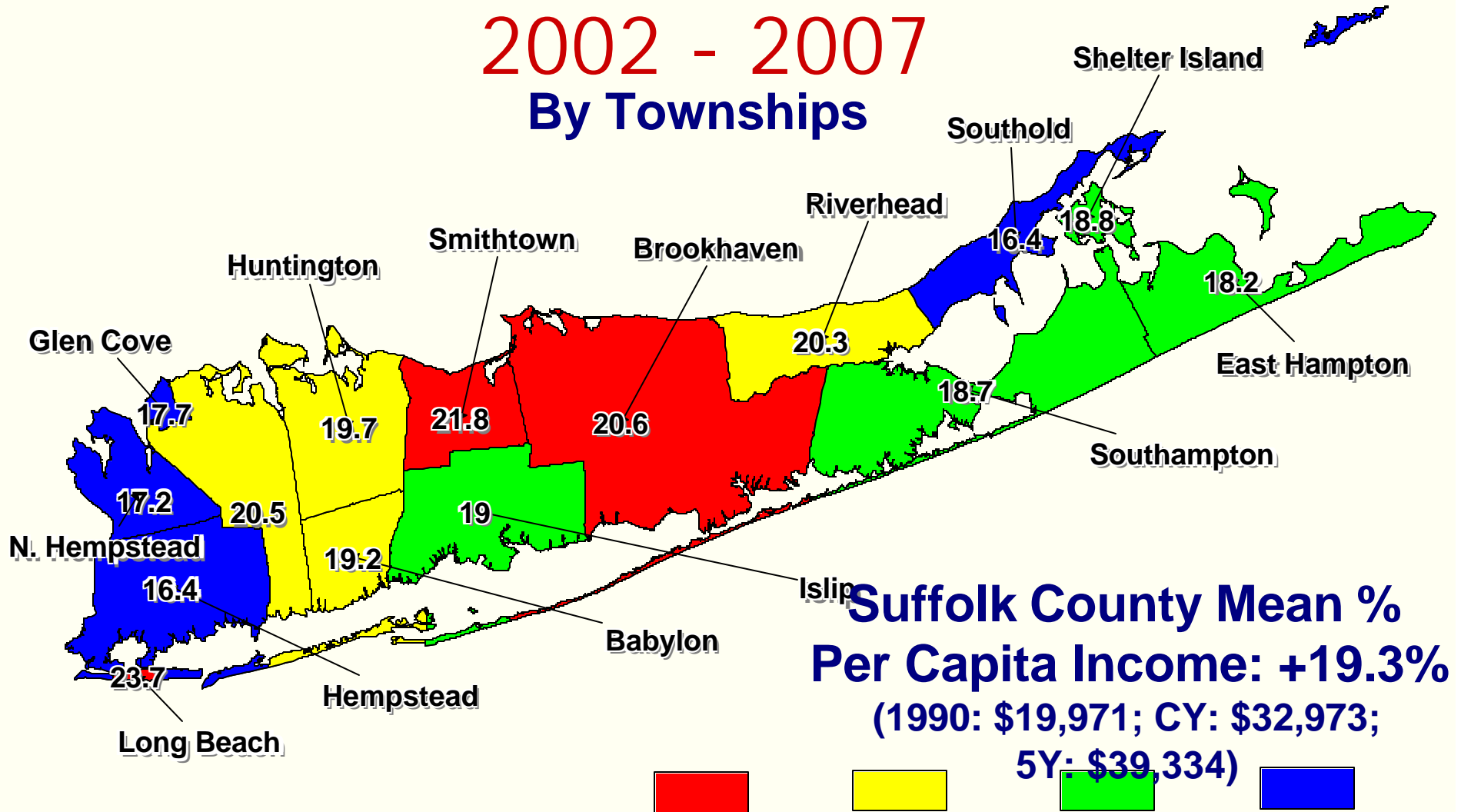

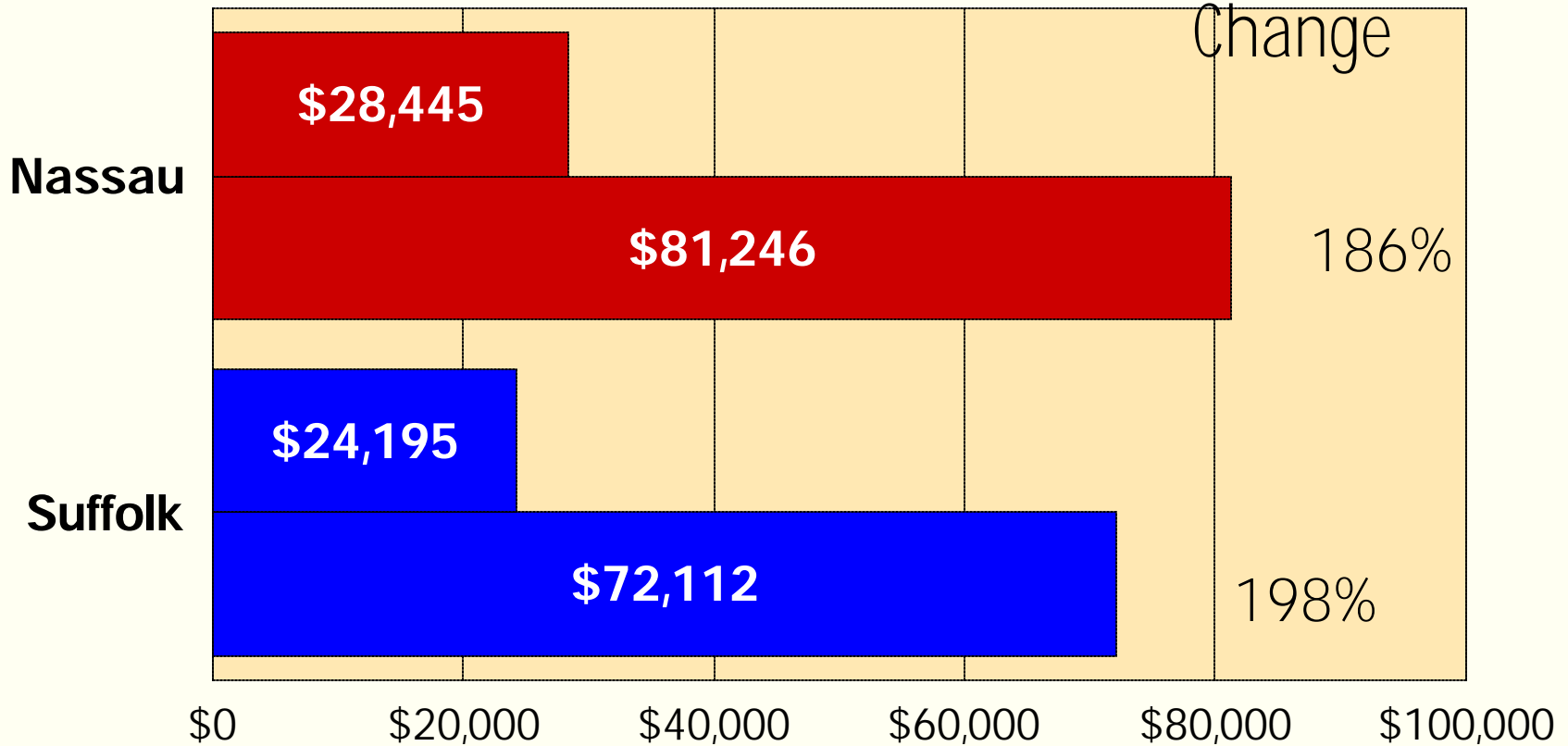

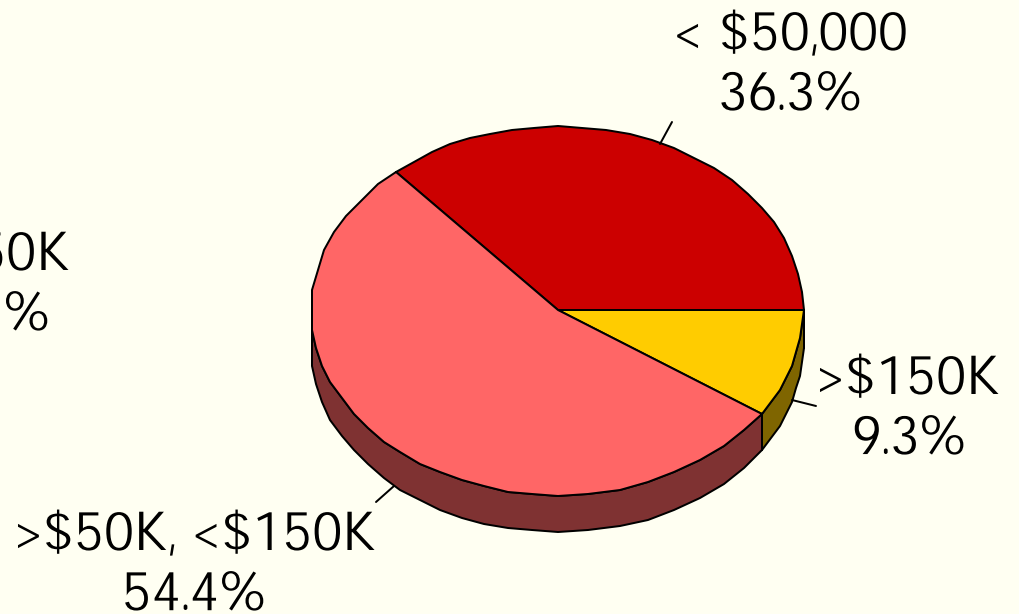


Household Income

Percent Distribution, 2002



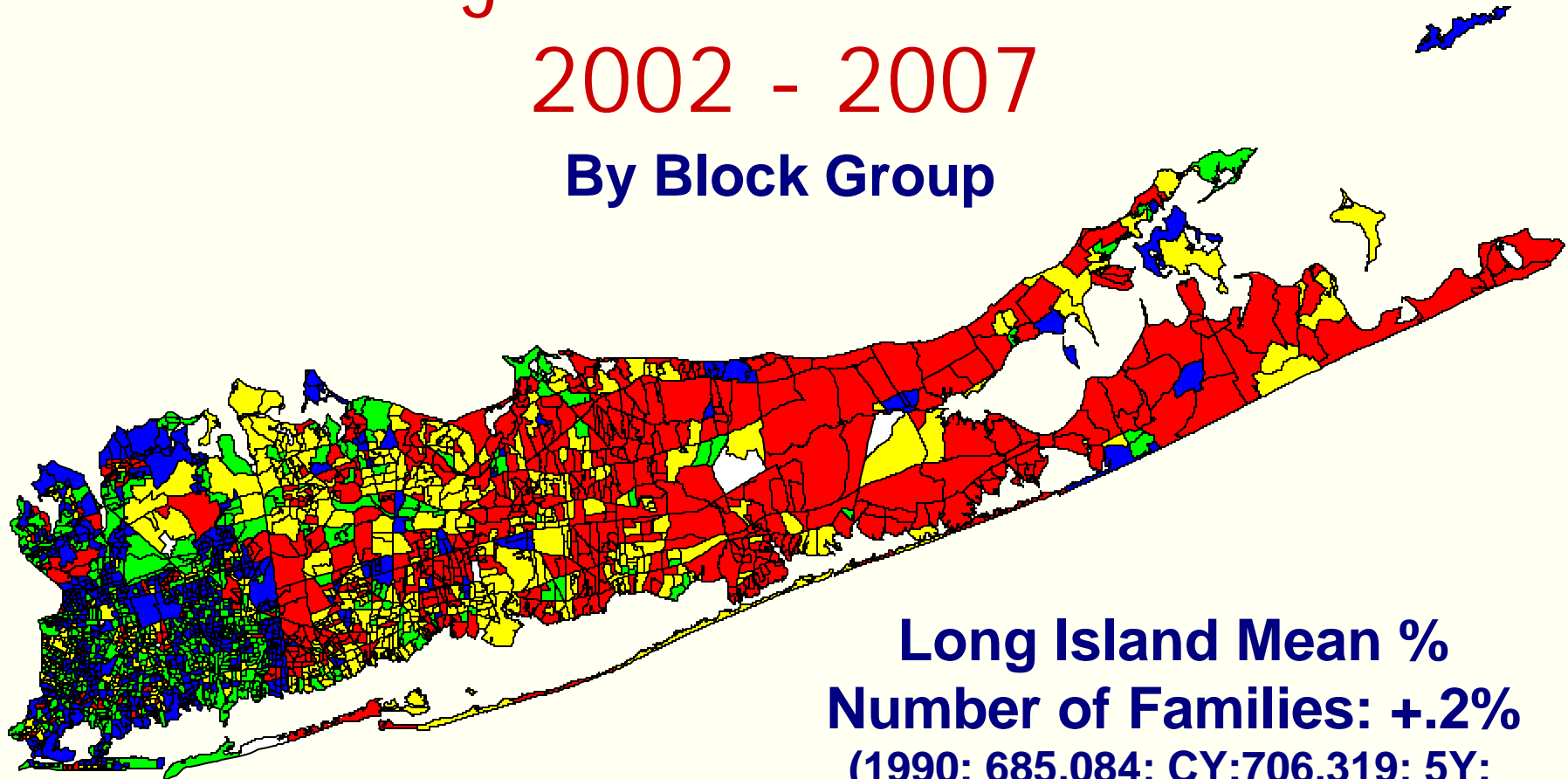

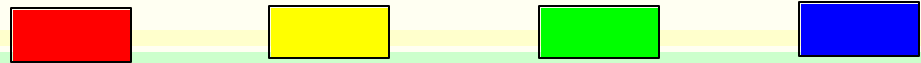

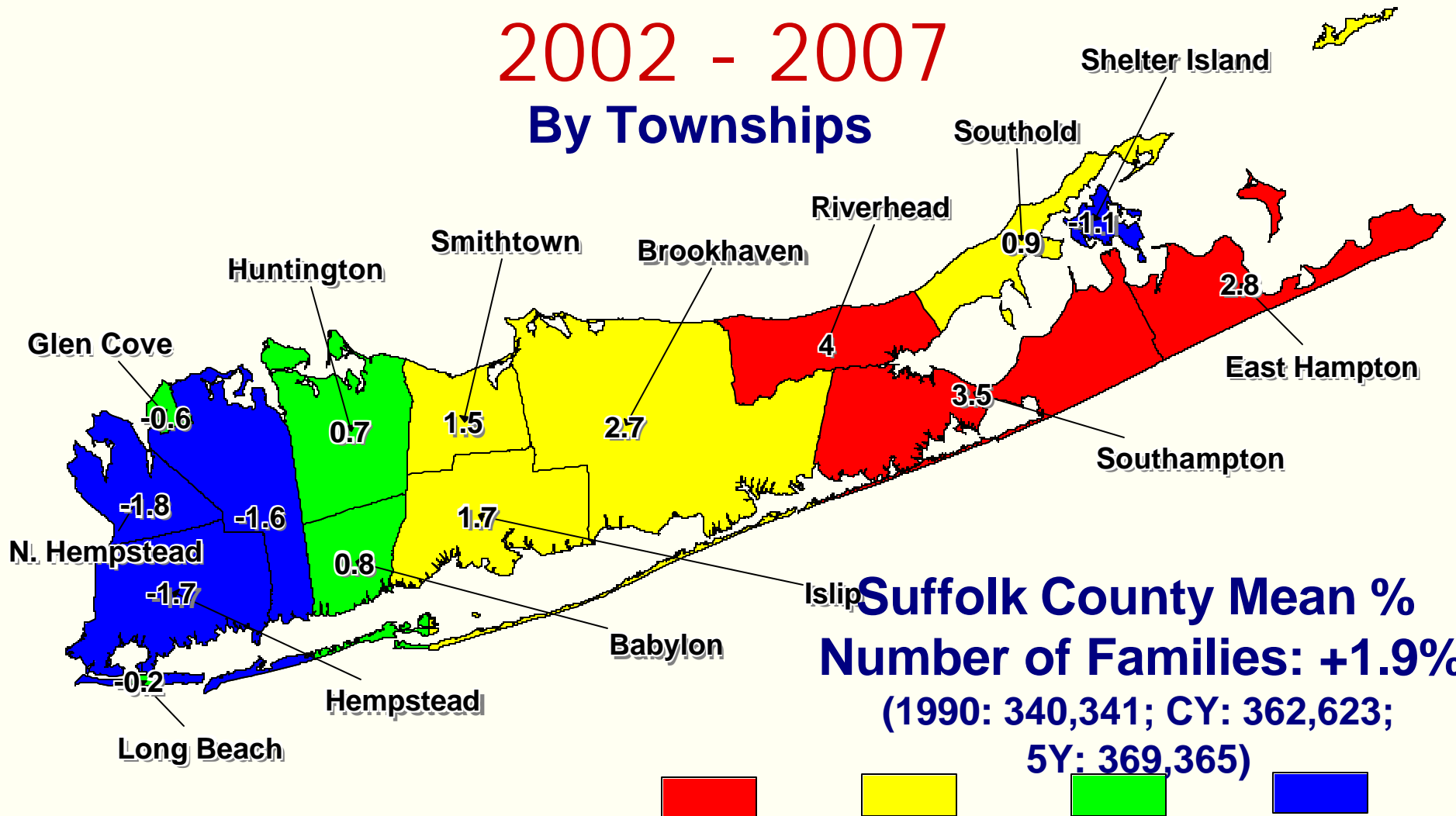

% Change in Number of Families: 2002 - 2007 By Townships



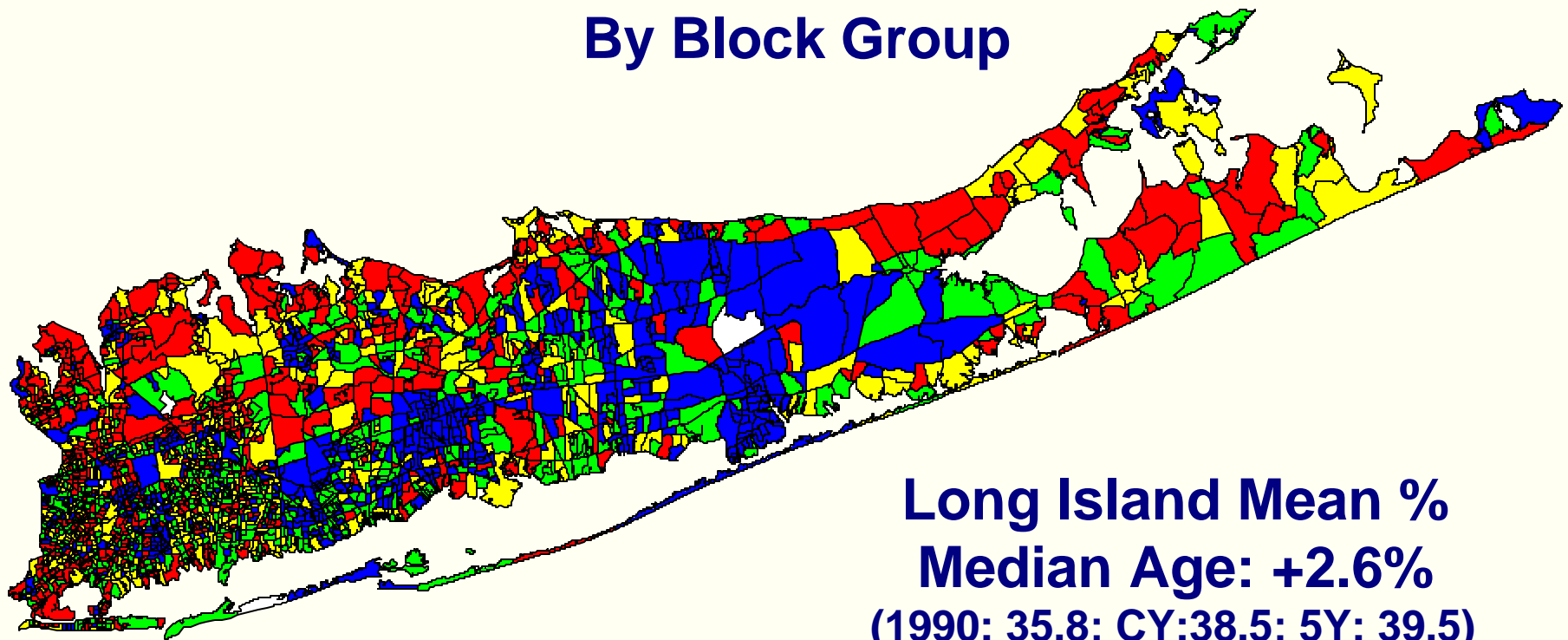

By Block Group**

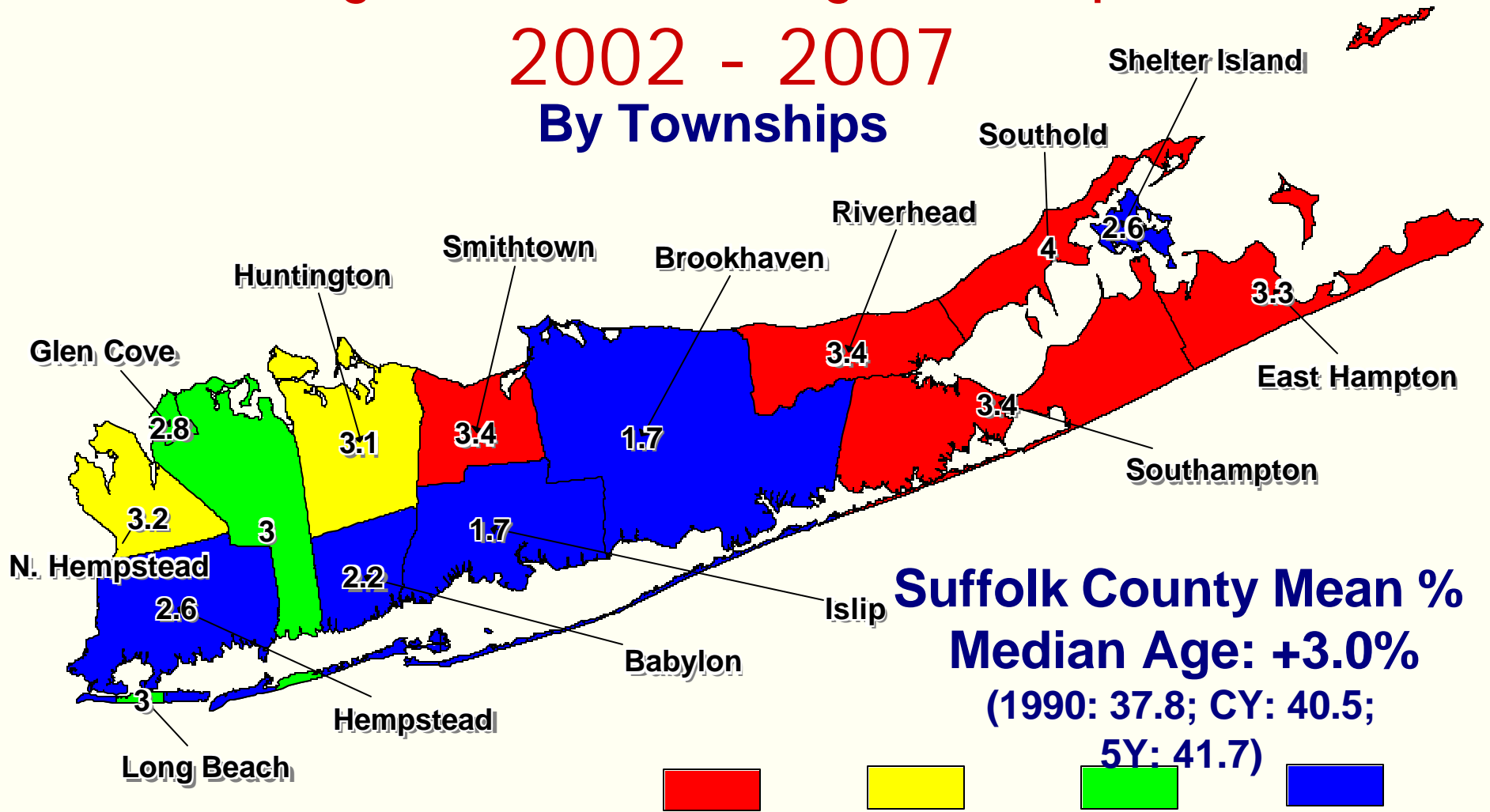

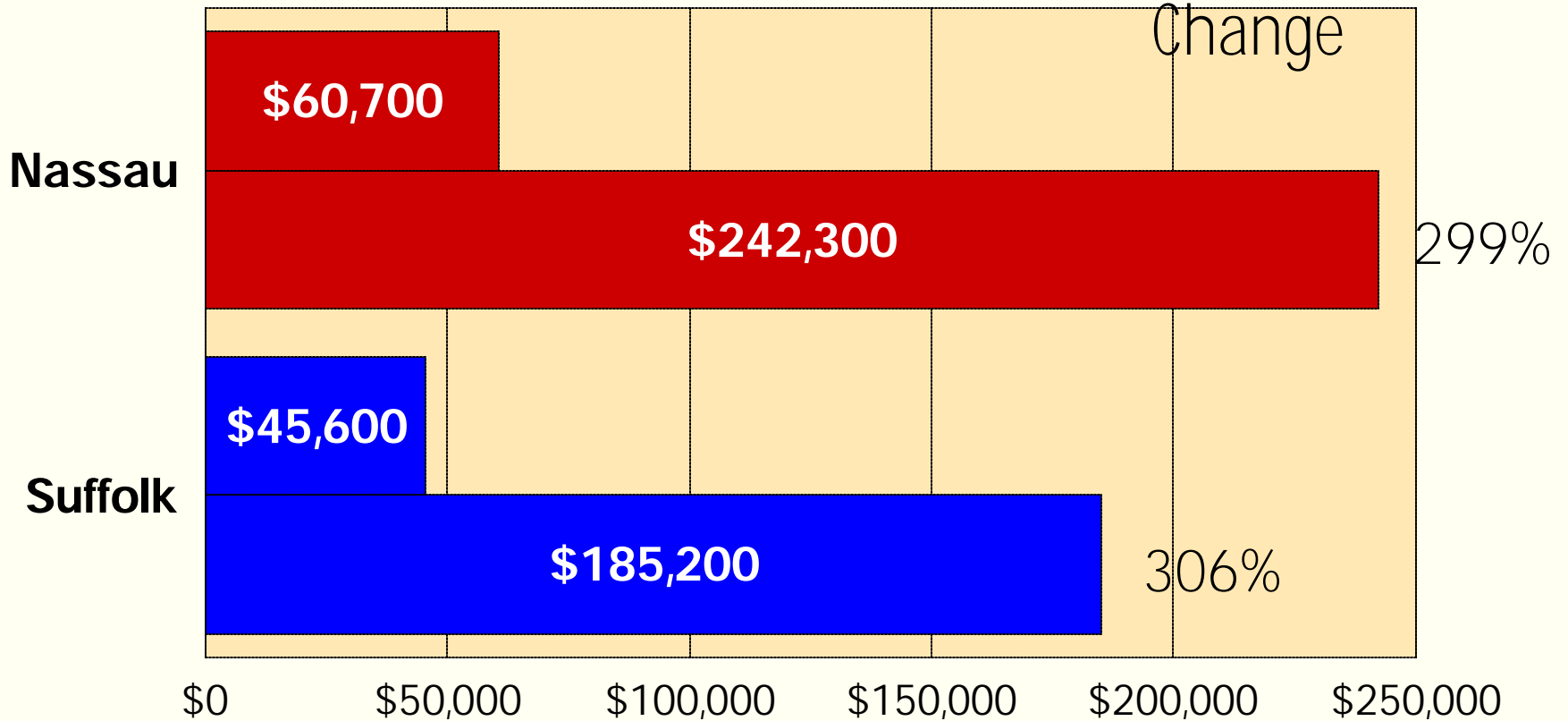

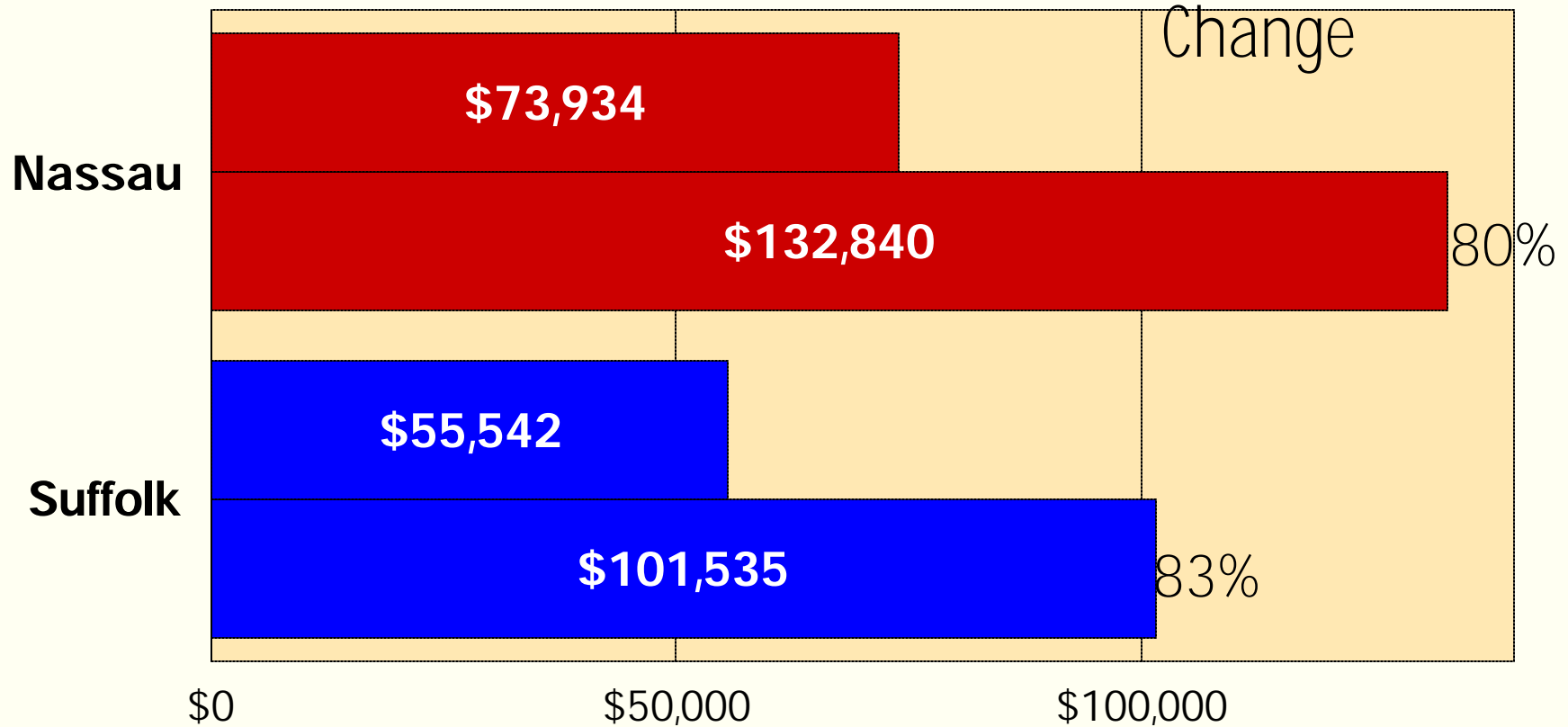

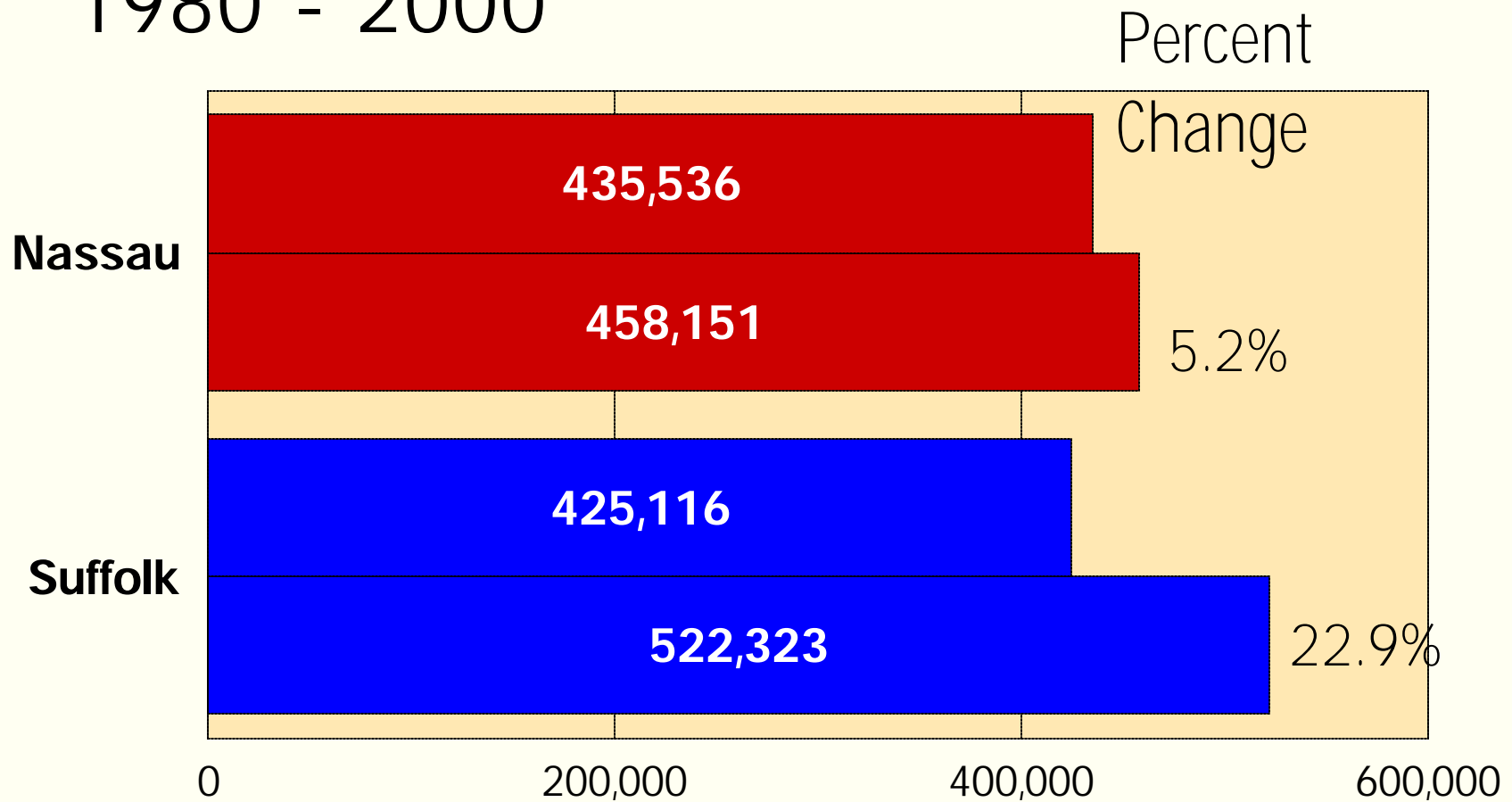

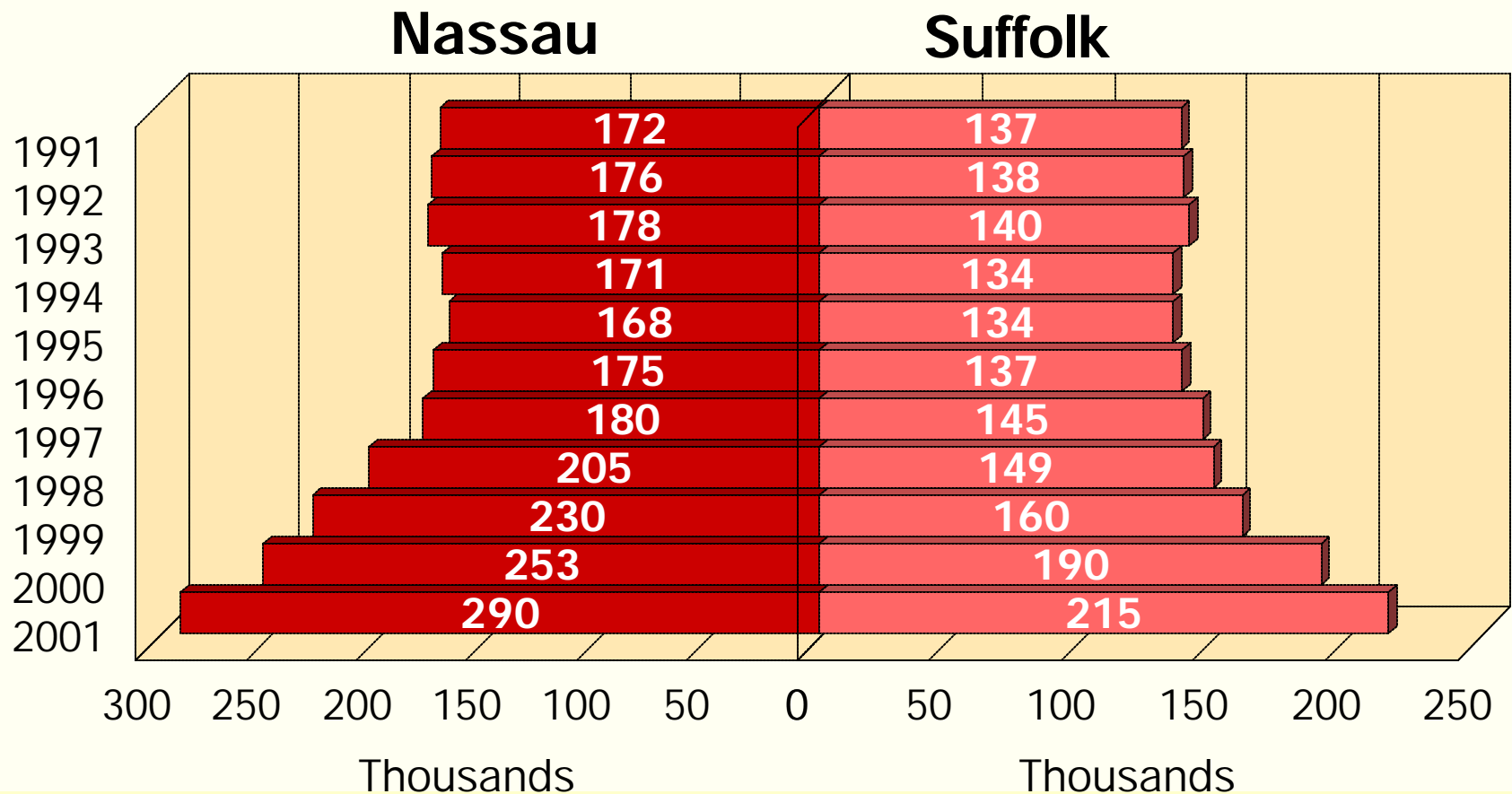

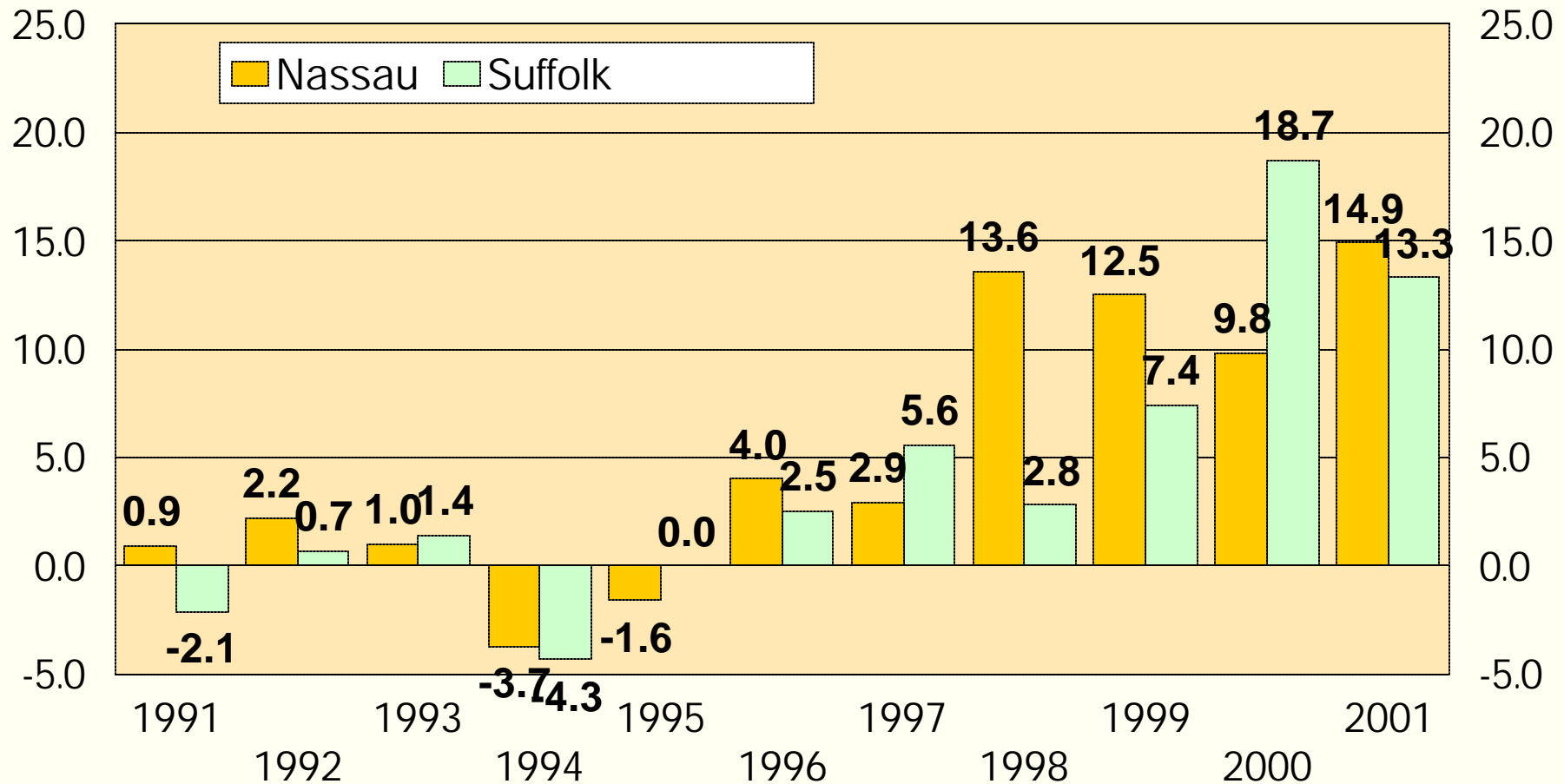
Median Home Prices on LI

Average Annual Change (\$)



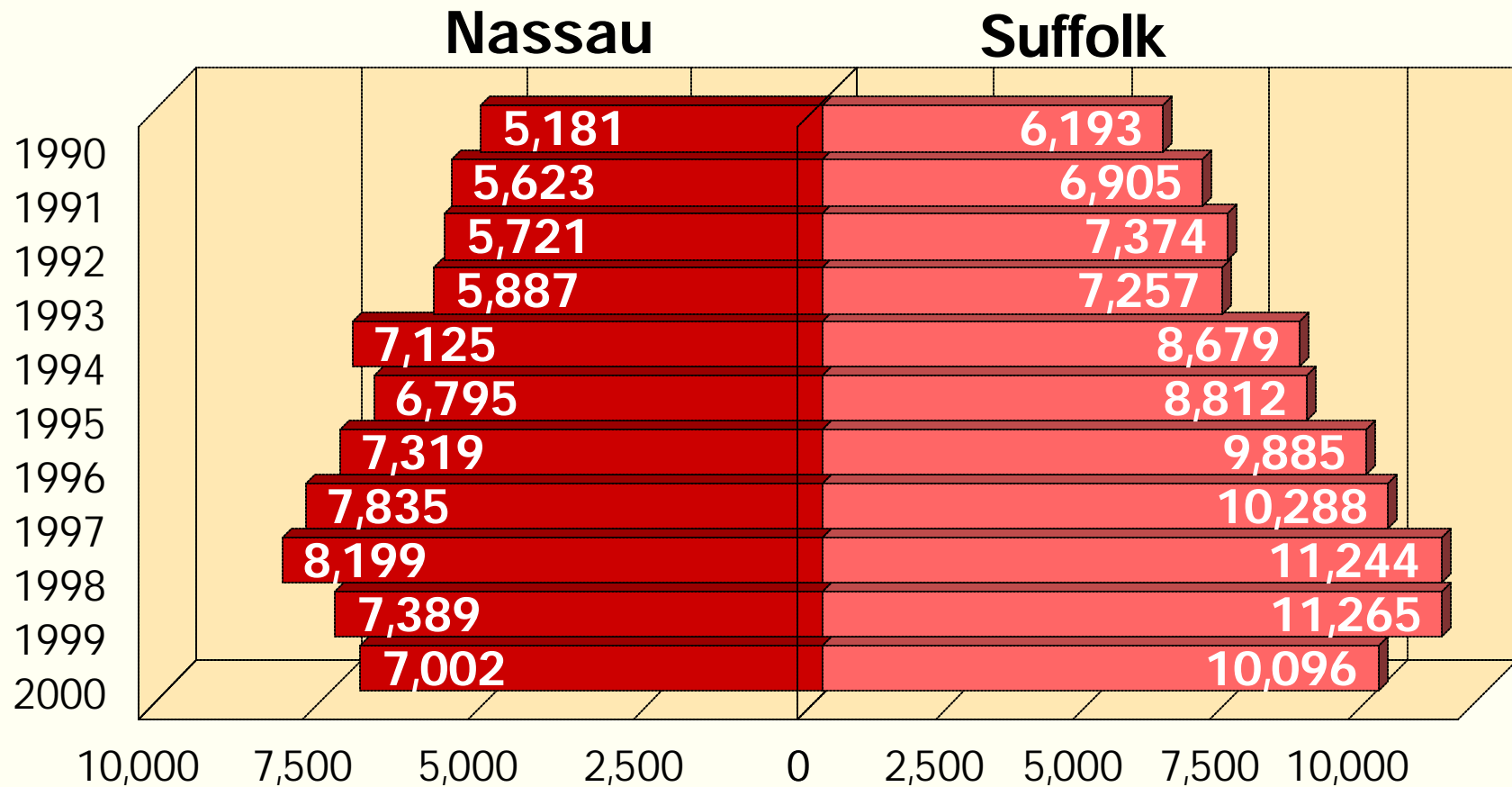
Median Home Prices on LI

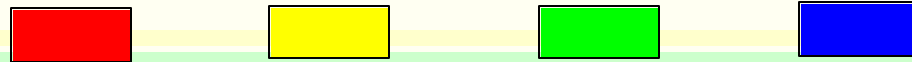
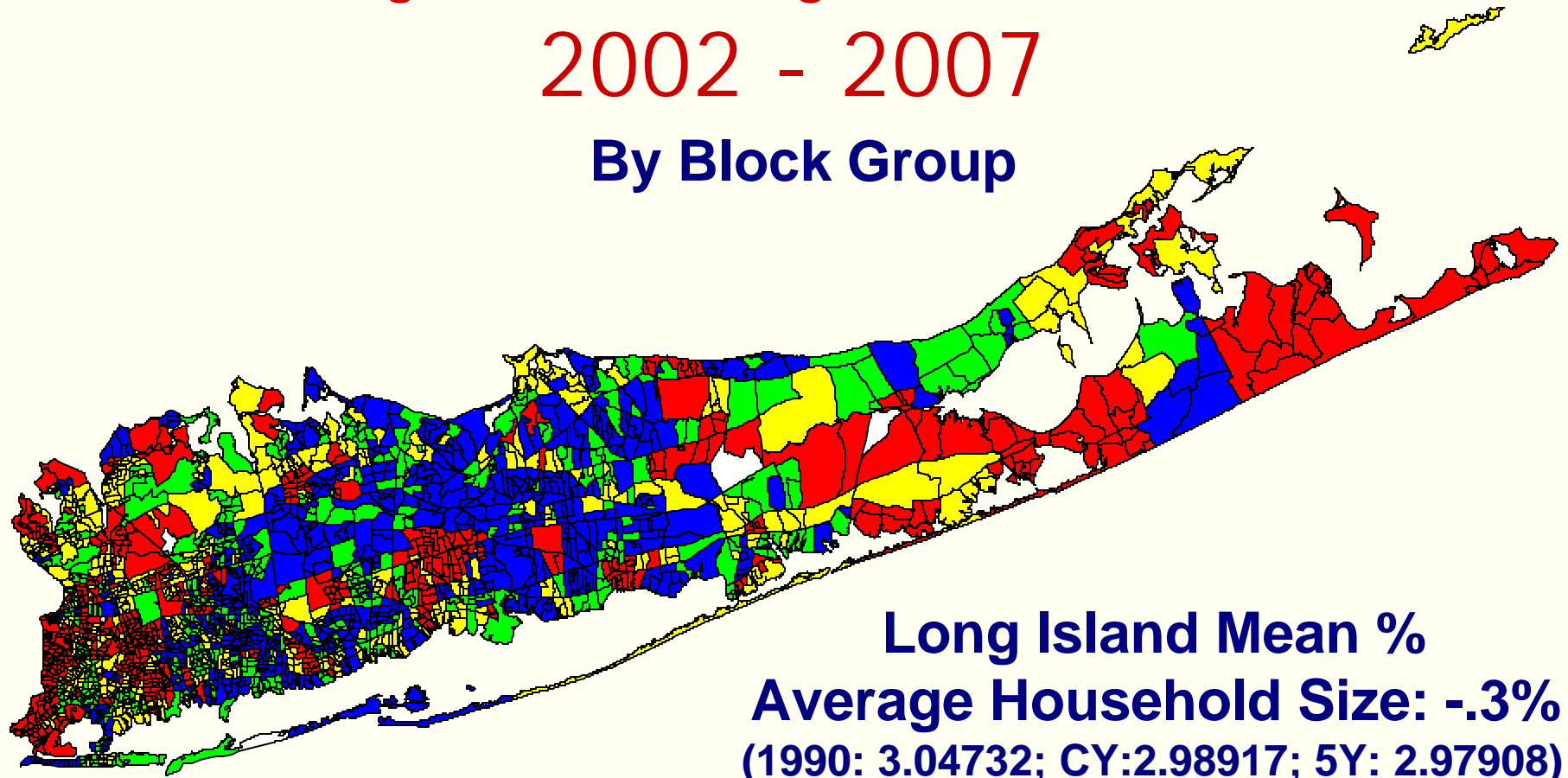
Residential Home Sales

Number of Homes, 2001



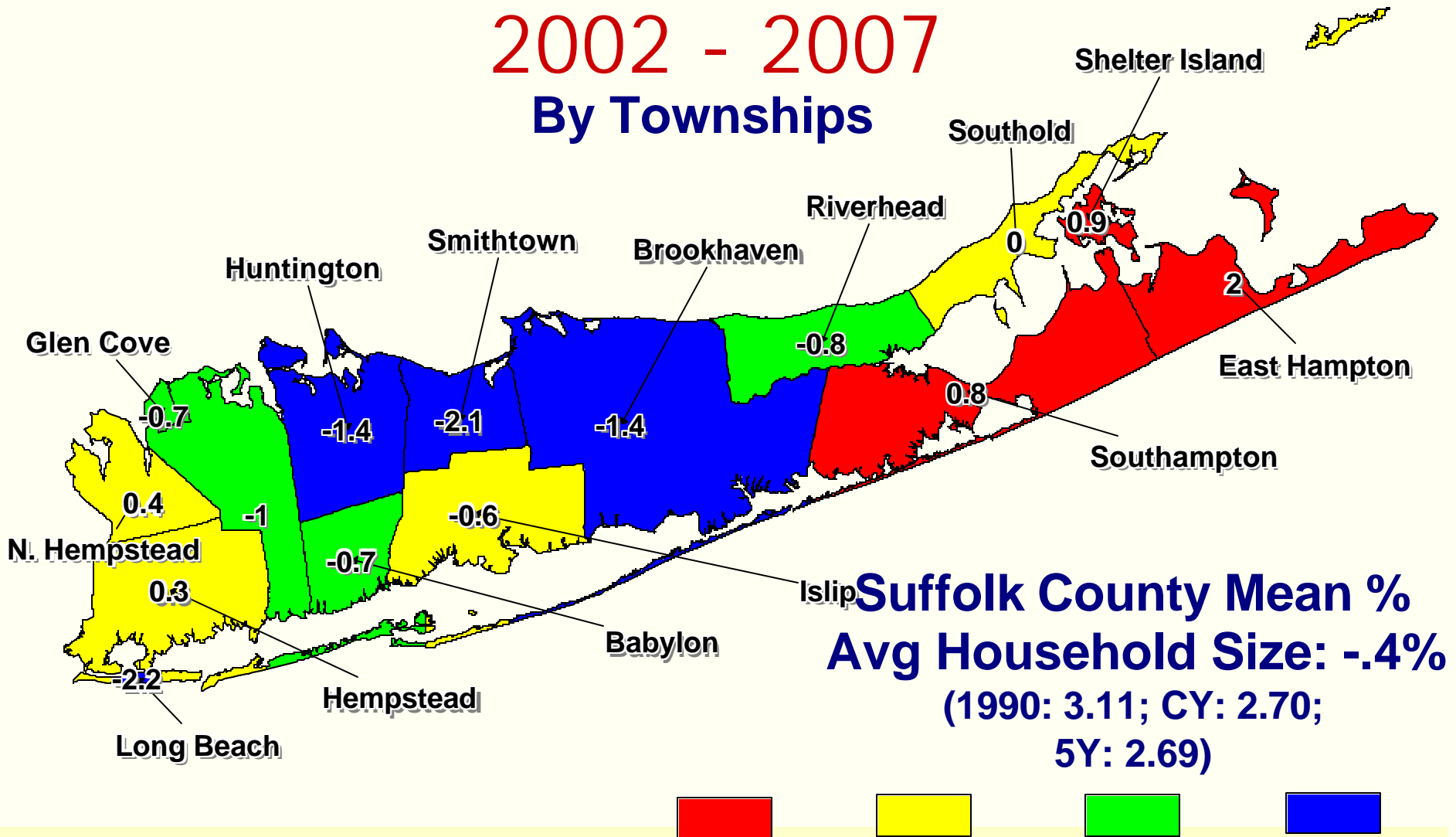
% Change in Average Household Size: 2002 - 2007

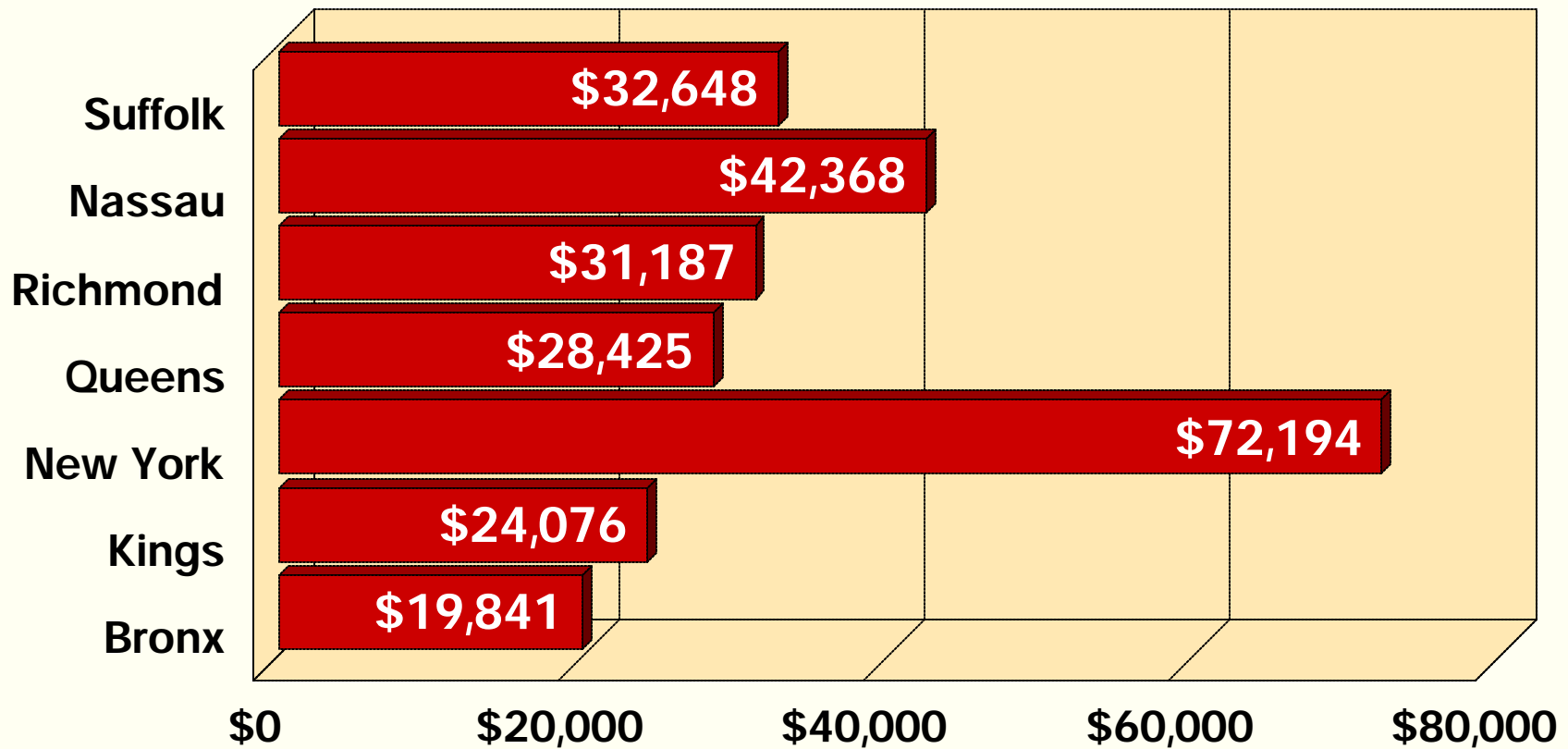

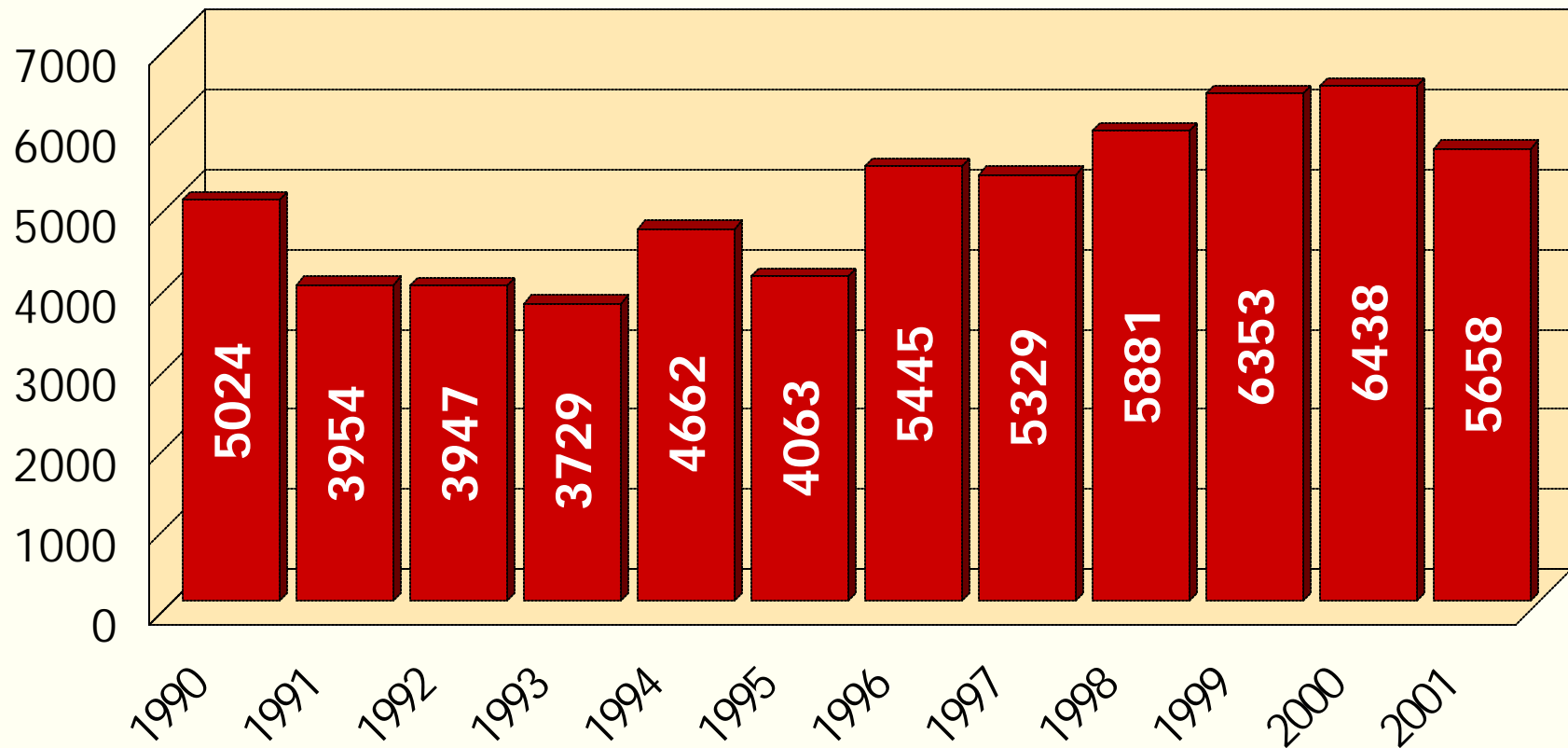

LI and New York City, 2001



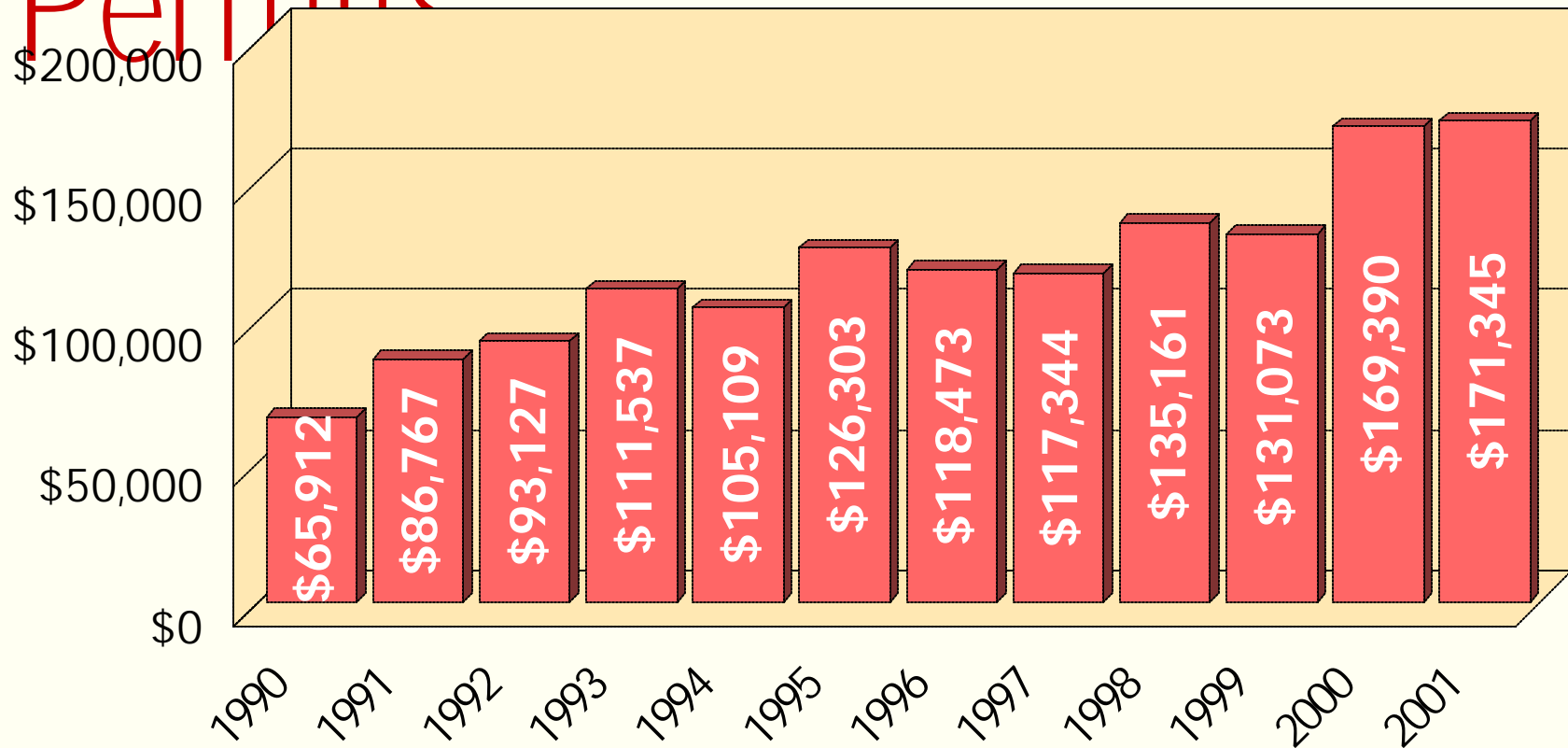
New Residential Permits

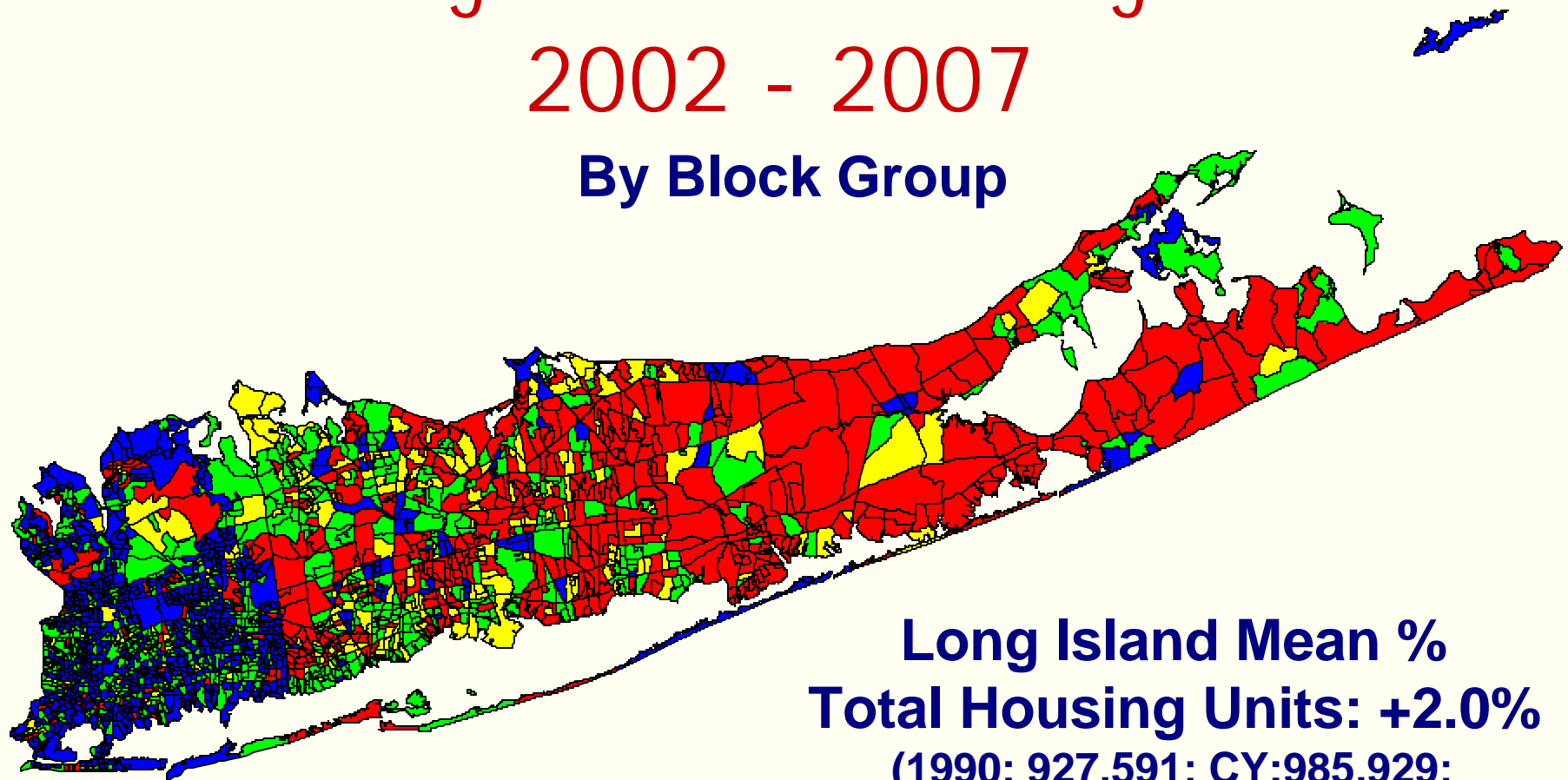

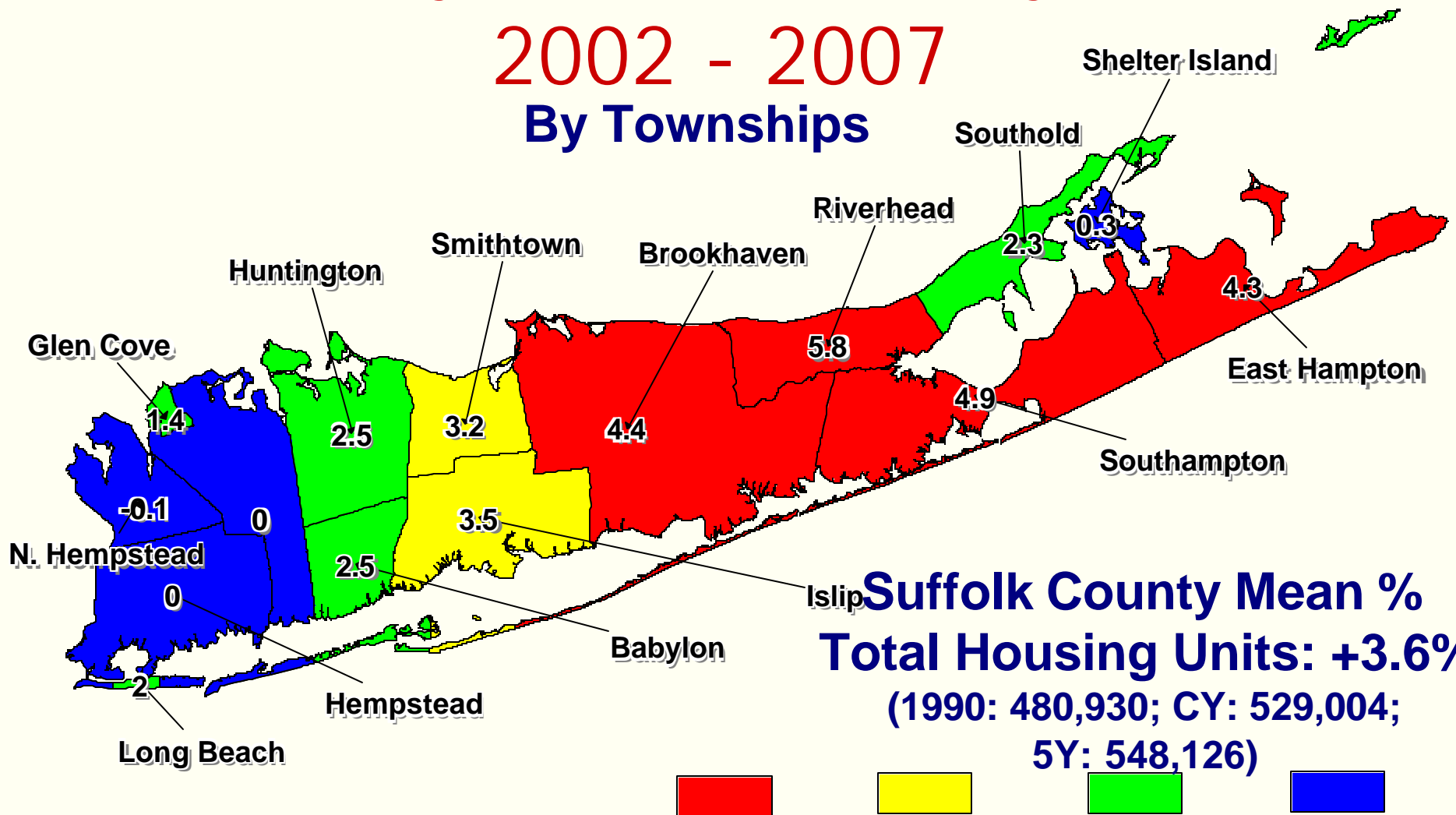

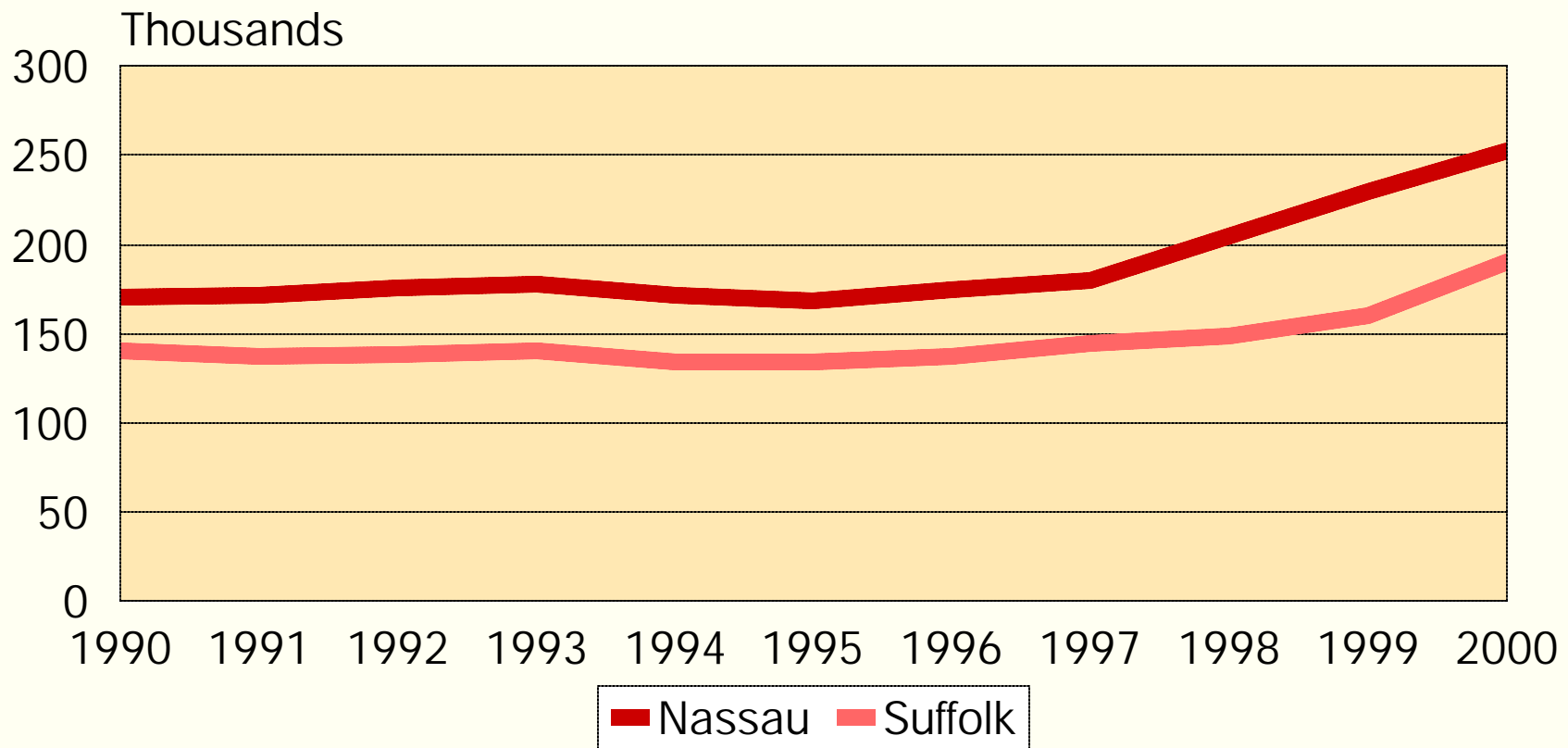

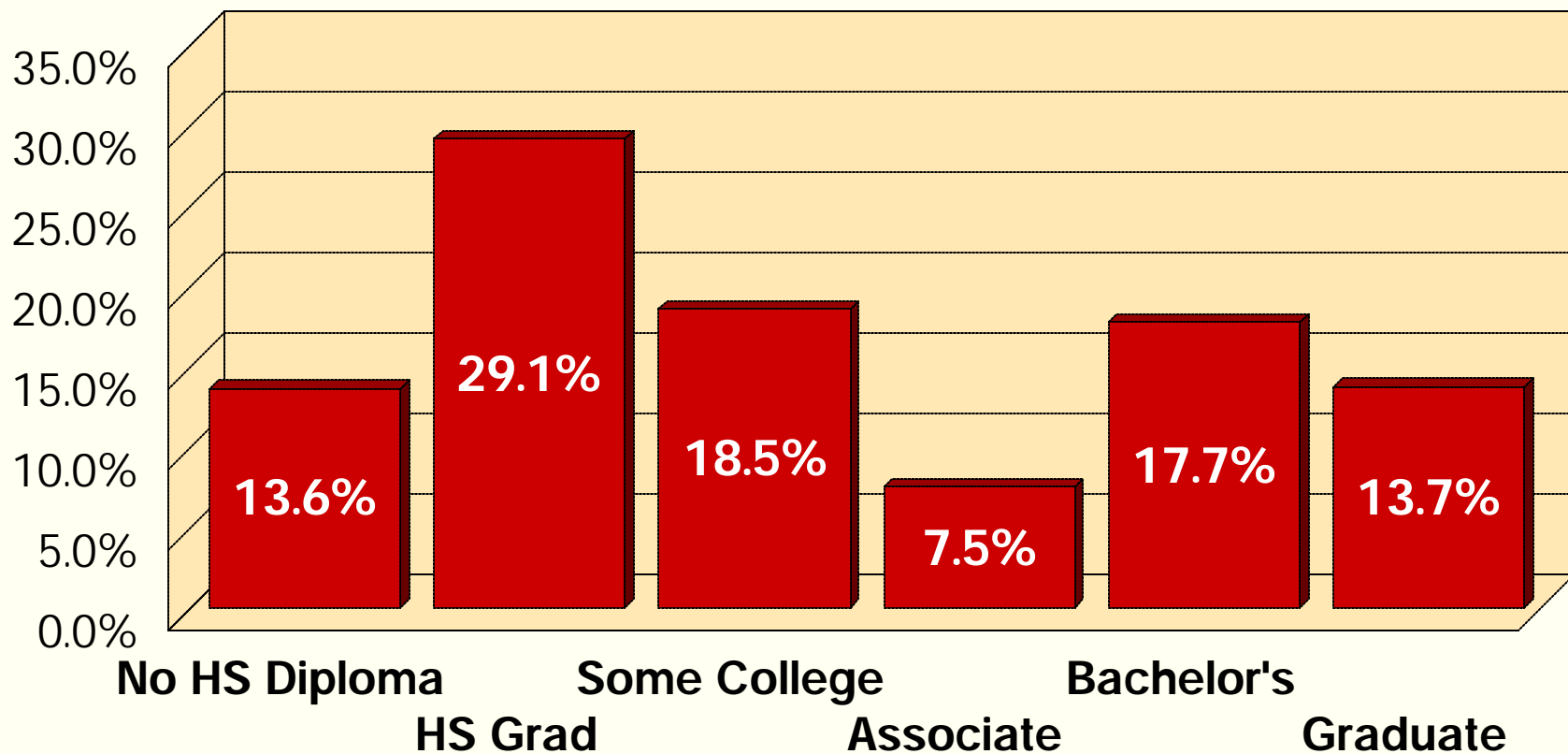

Percent Distribution, 2001

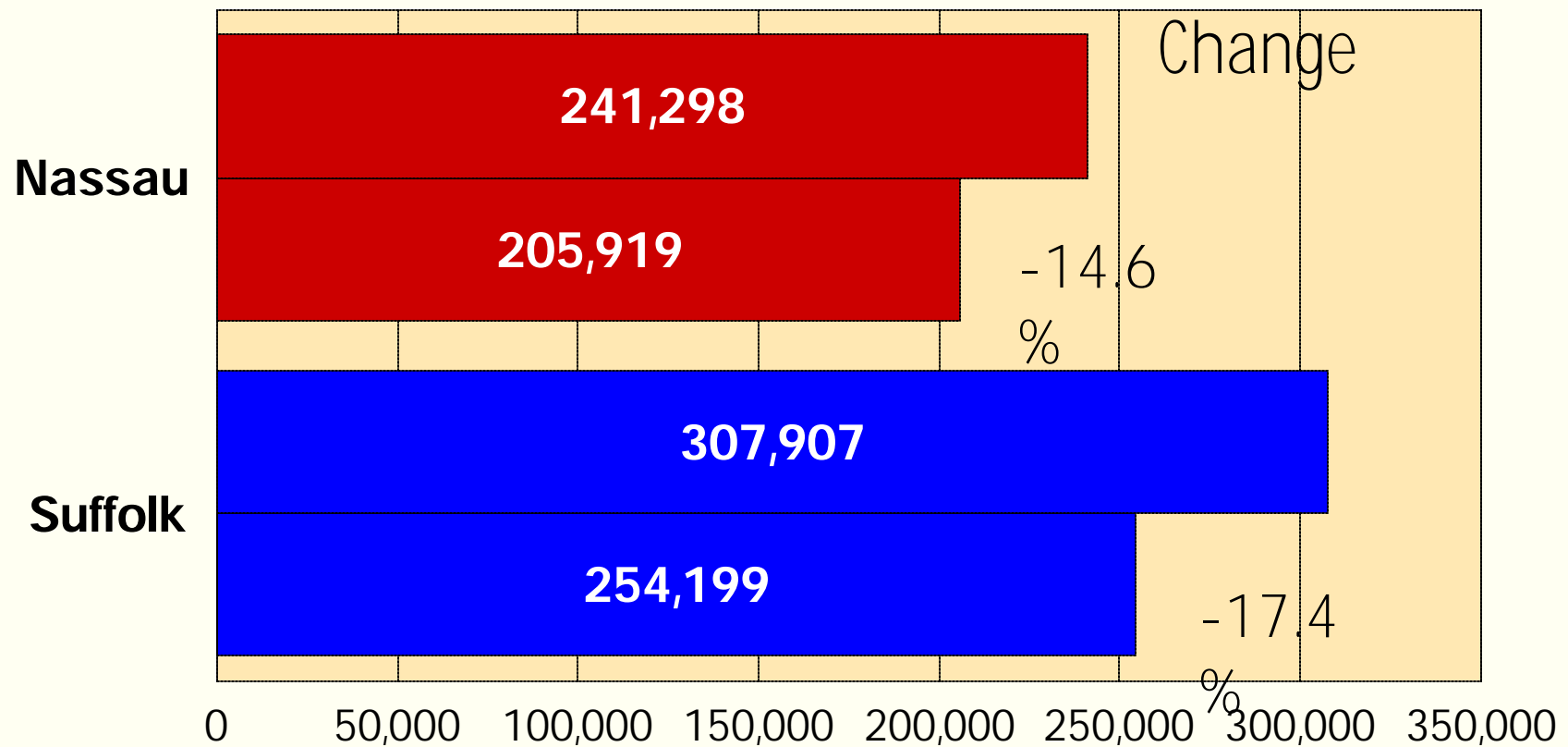

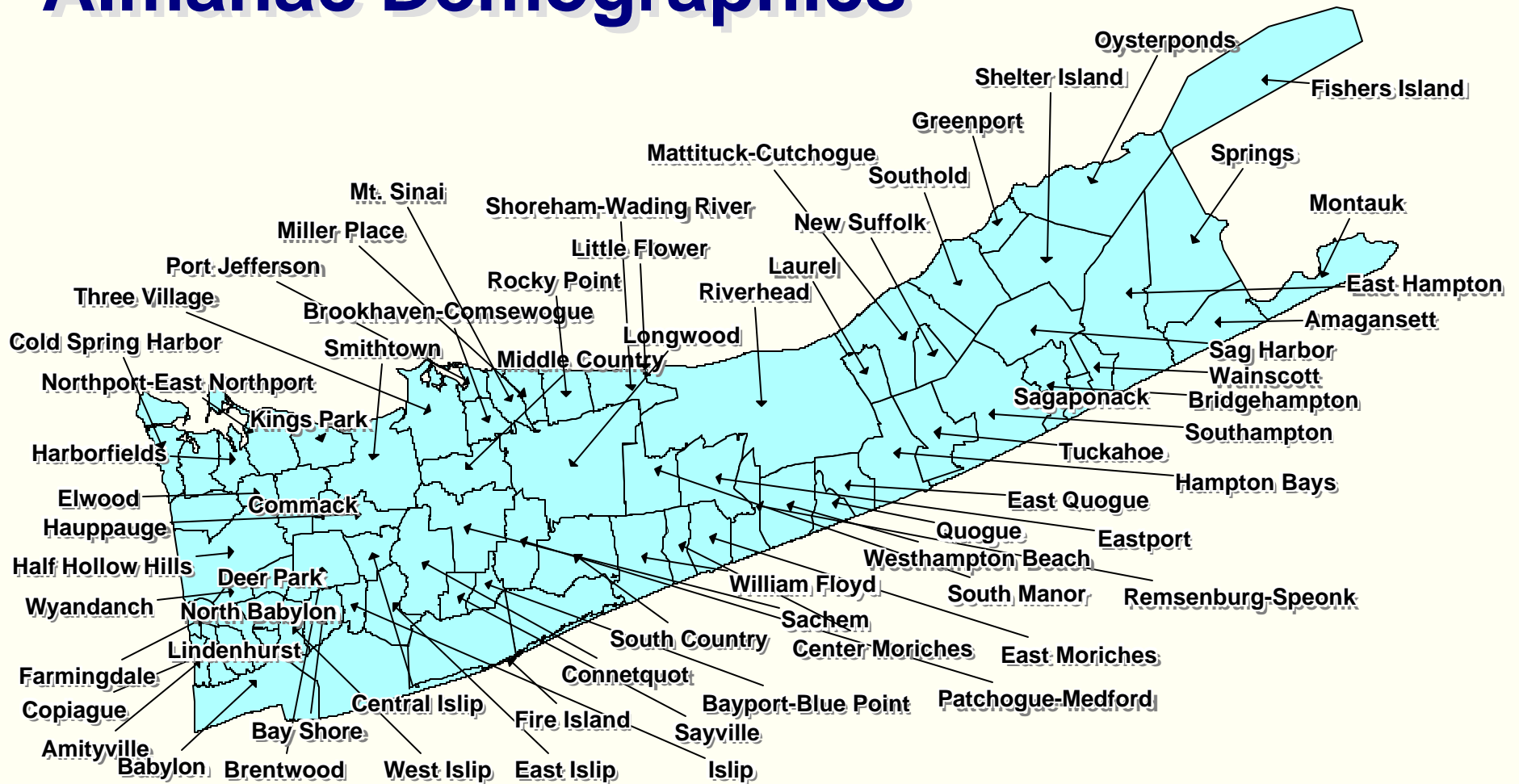

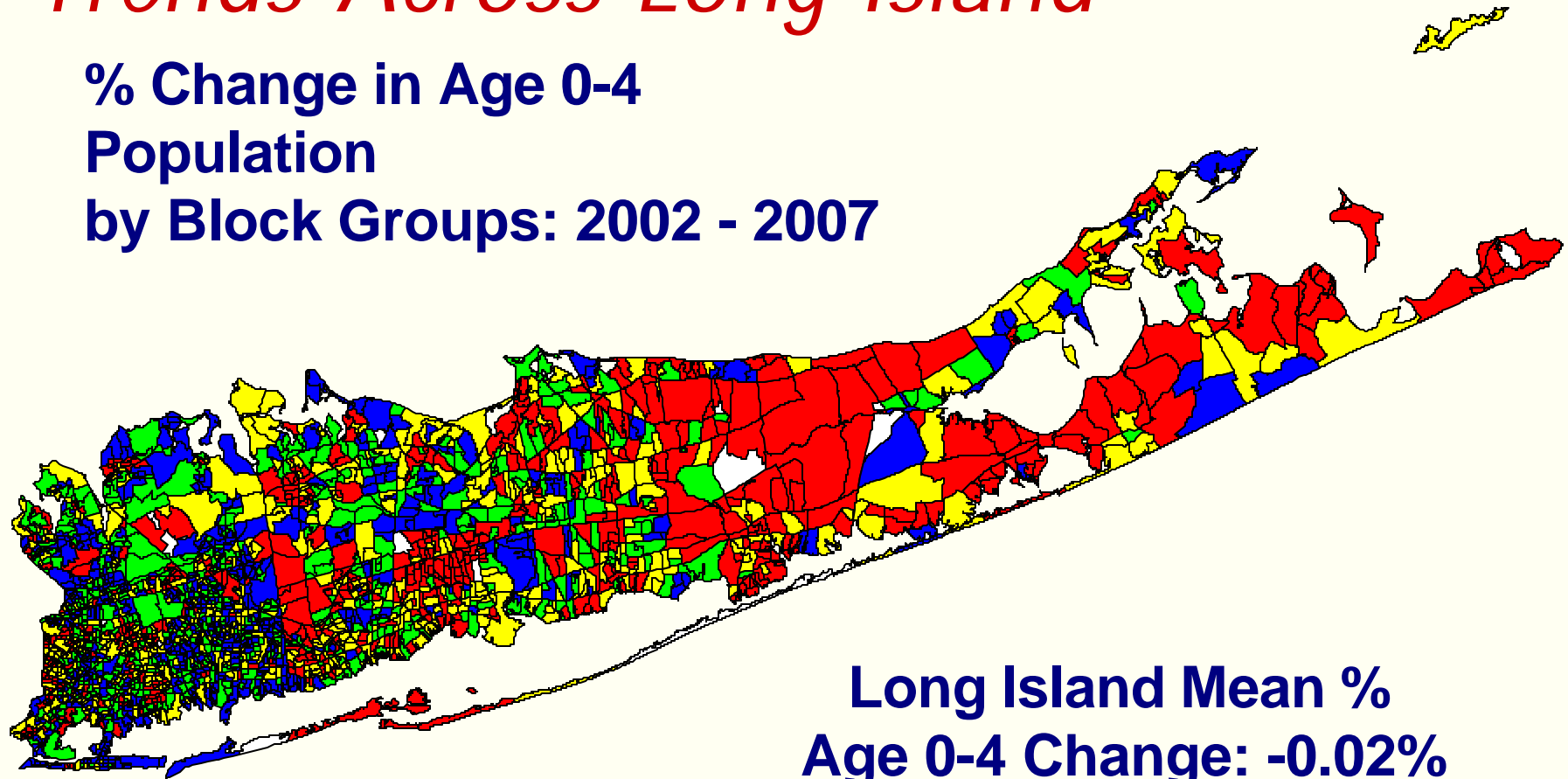

by Block Groups: 2002 - 2007**



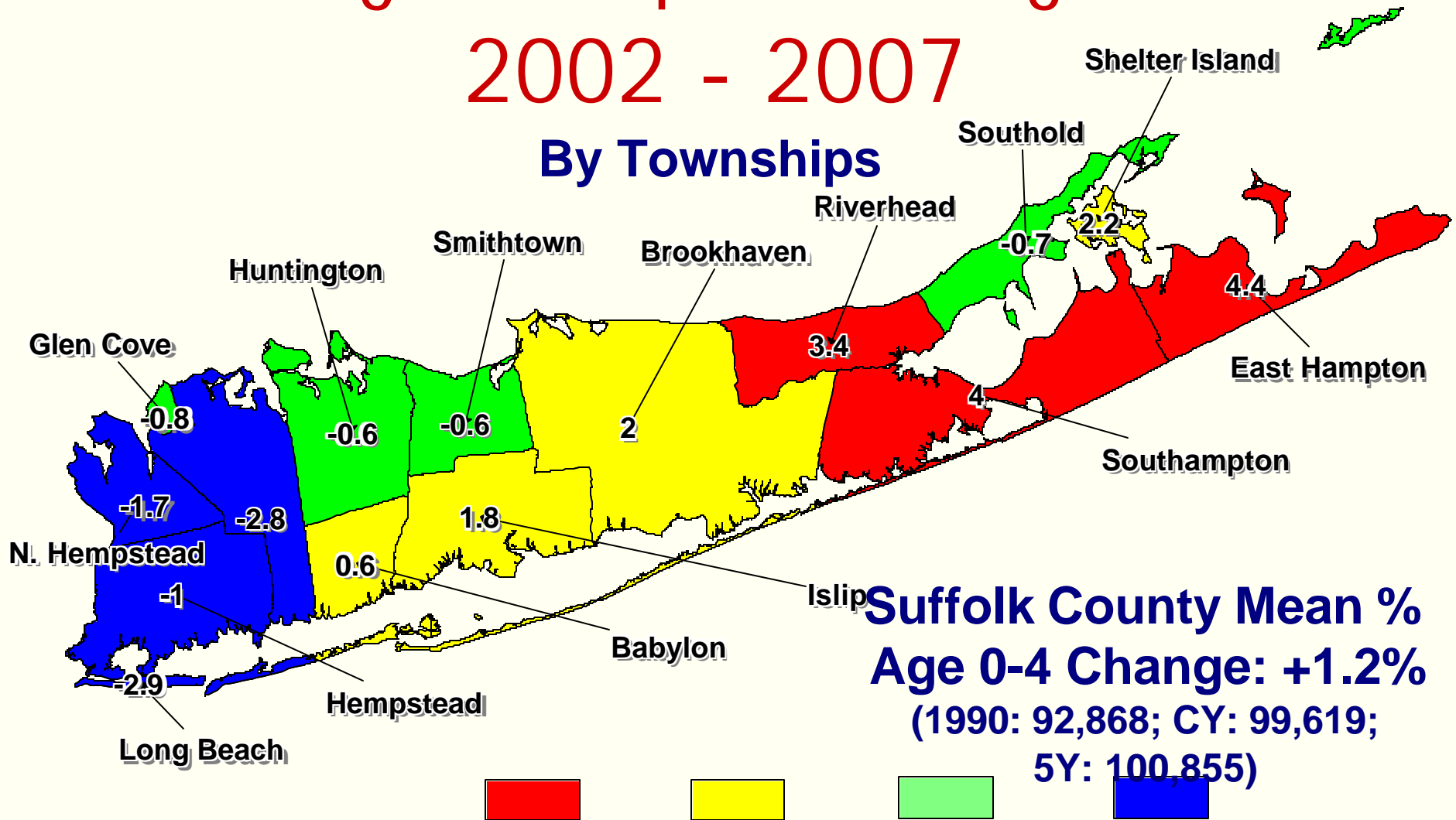

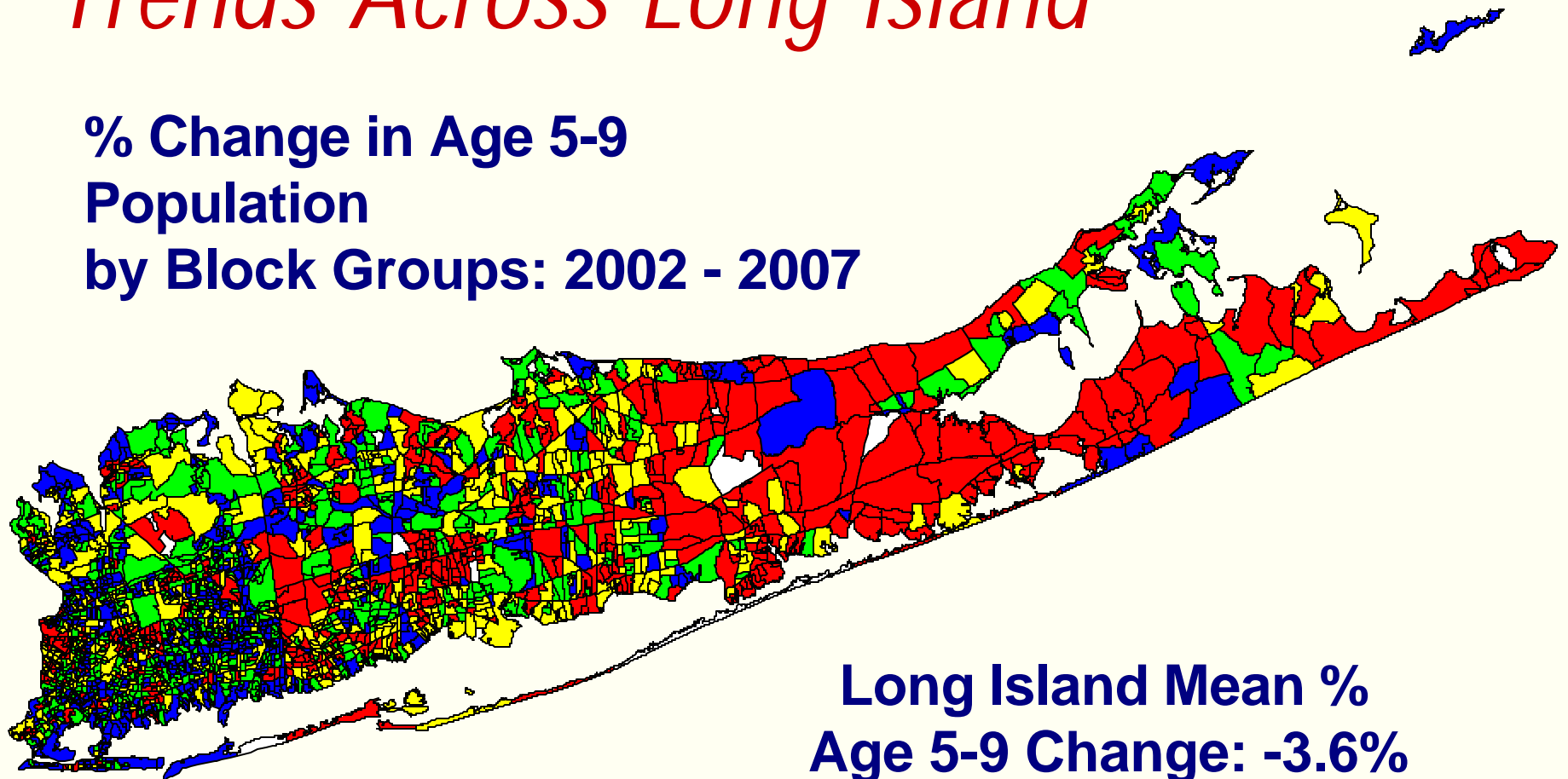

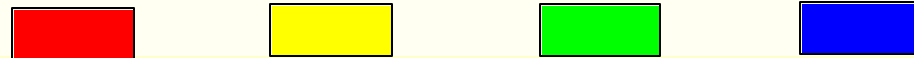

by Block Groups: 2002 - 2007**



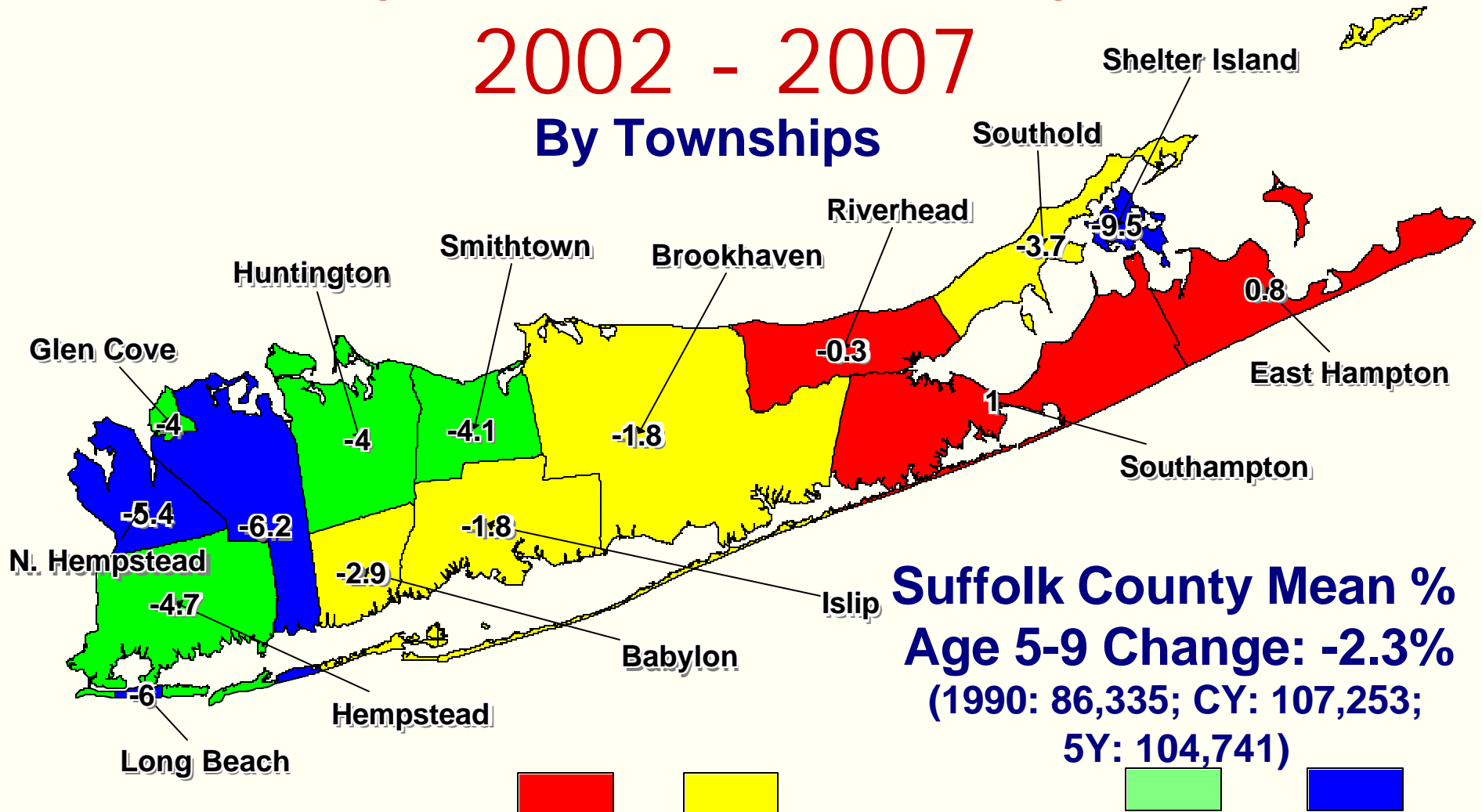

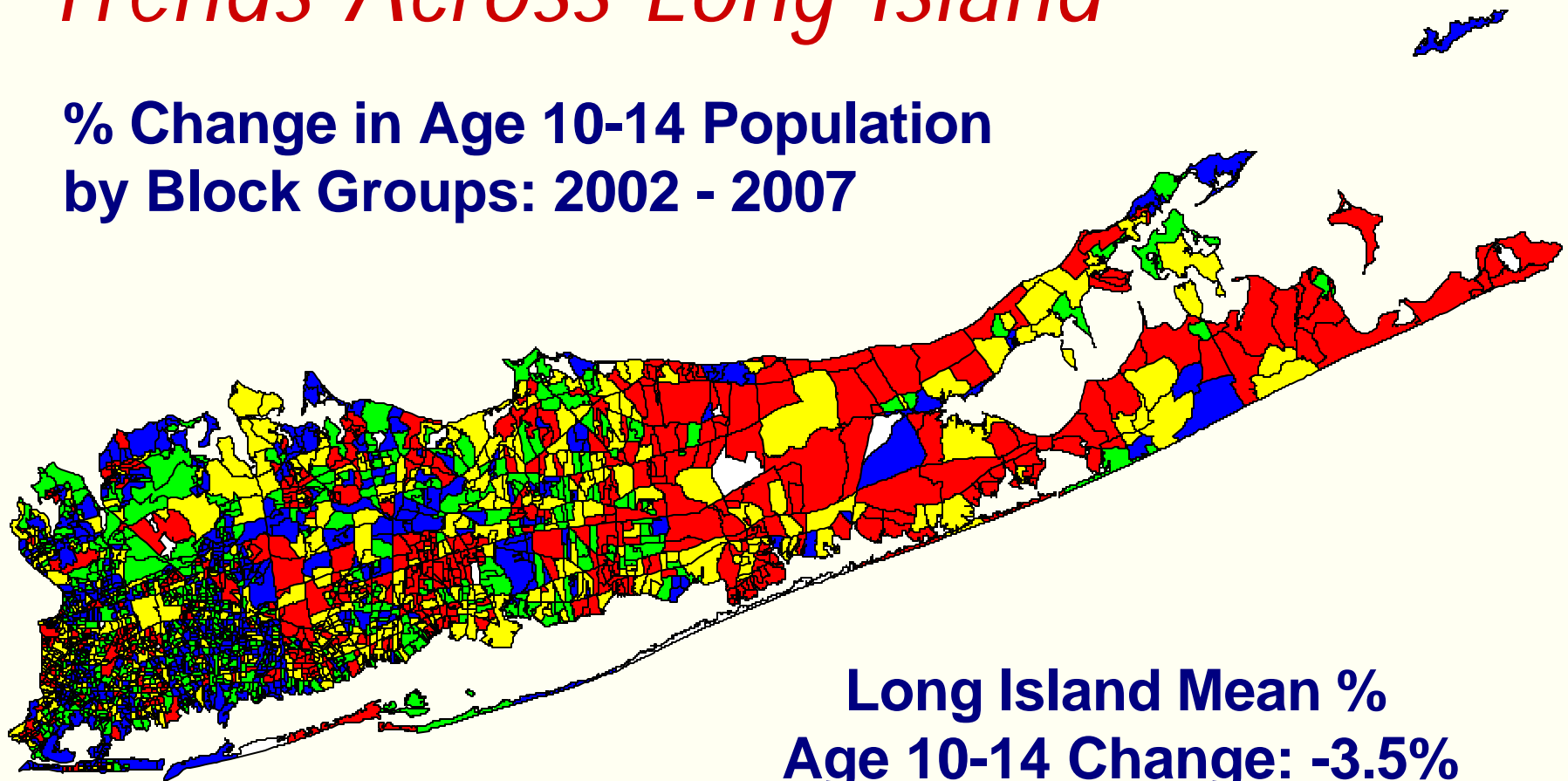

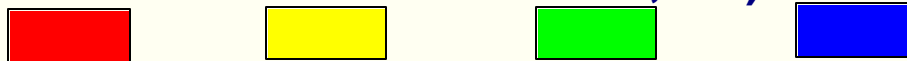

by Block Groups: 2002 - 2007**



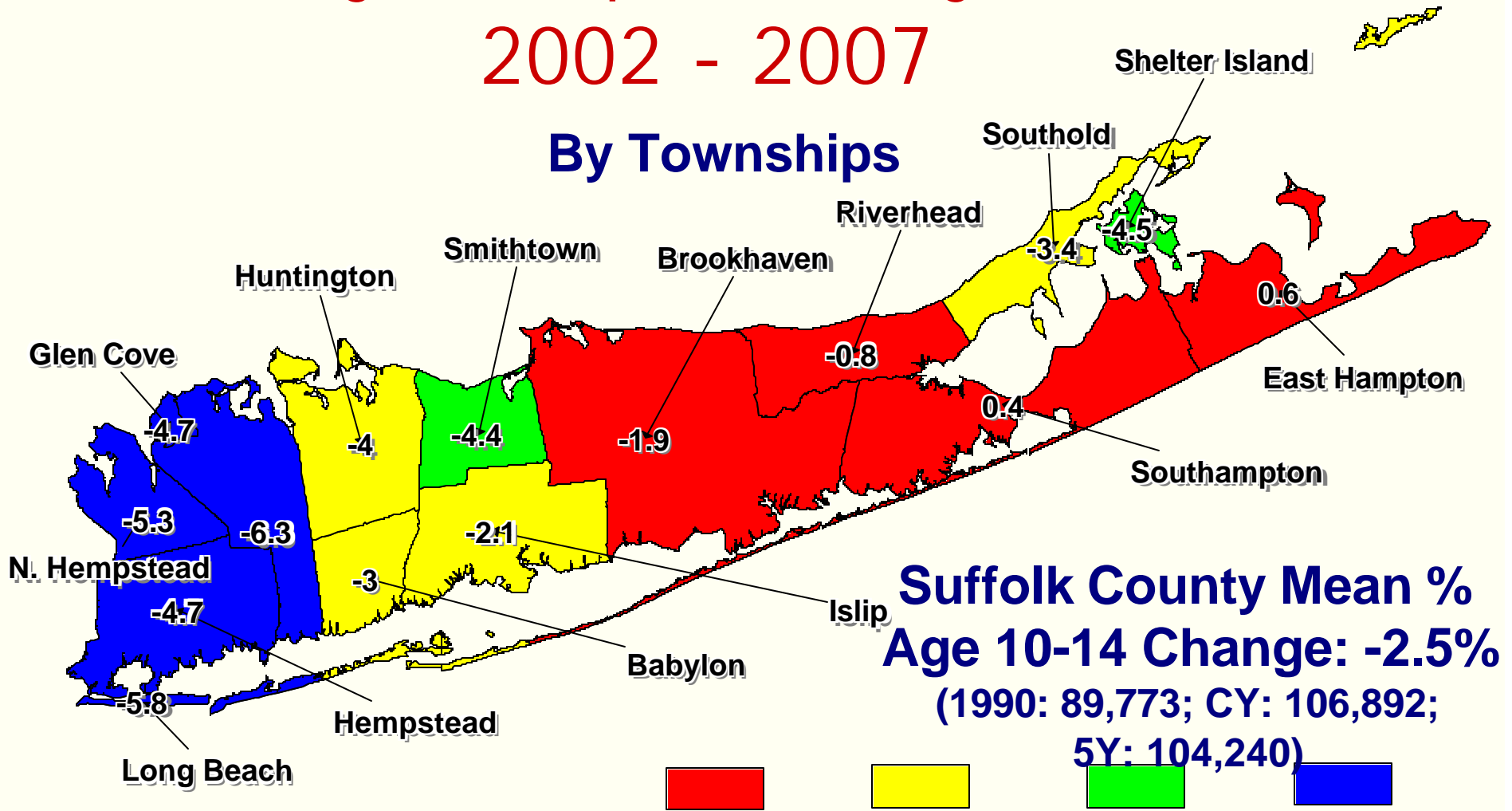

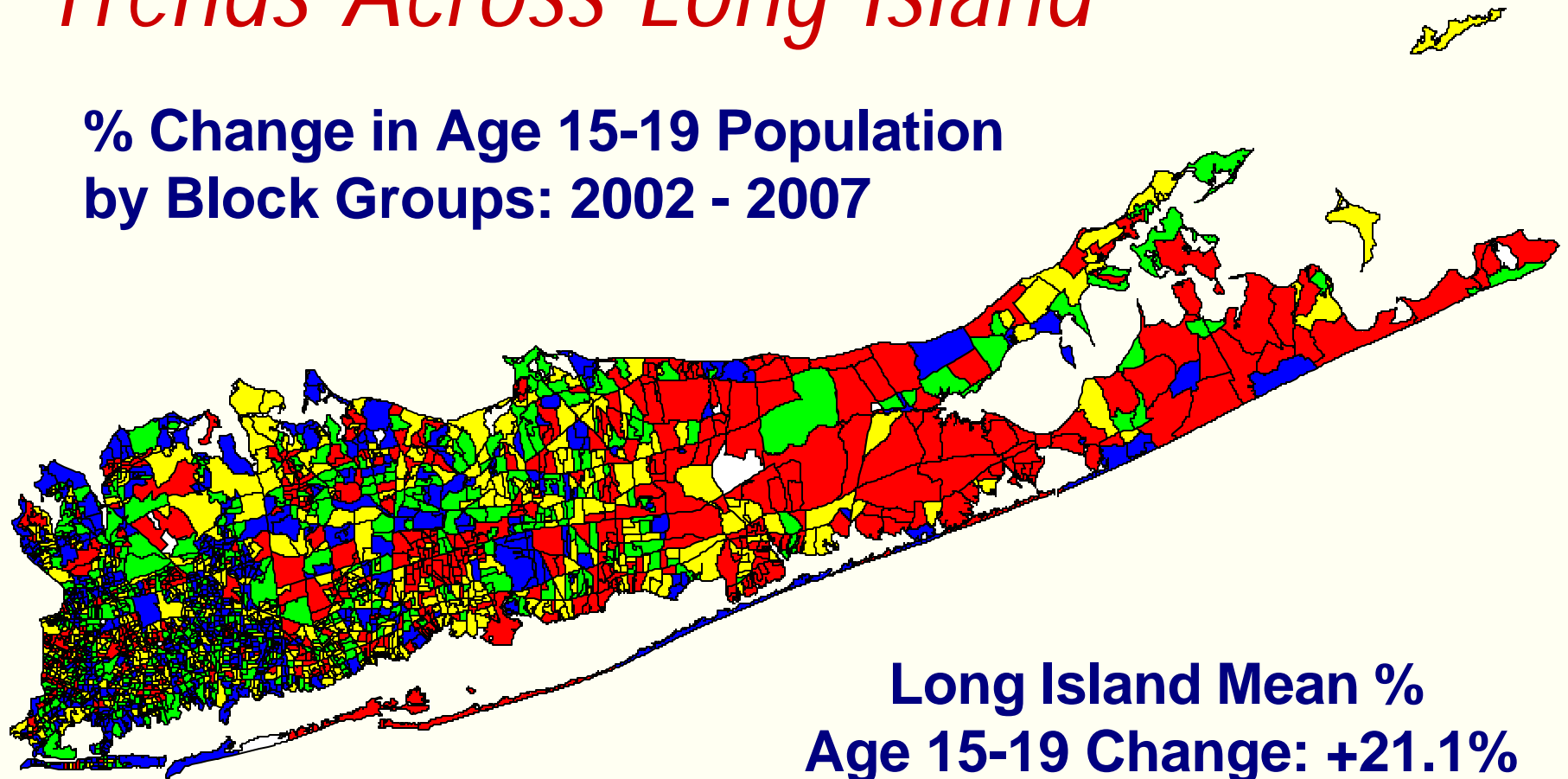

by Block Groups: 2002 - 2007**



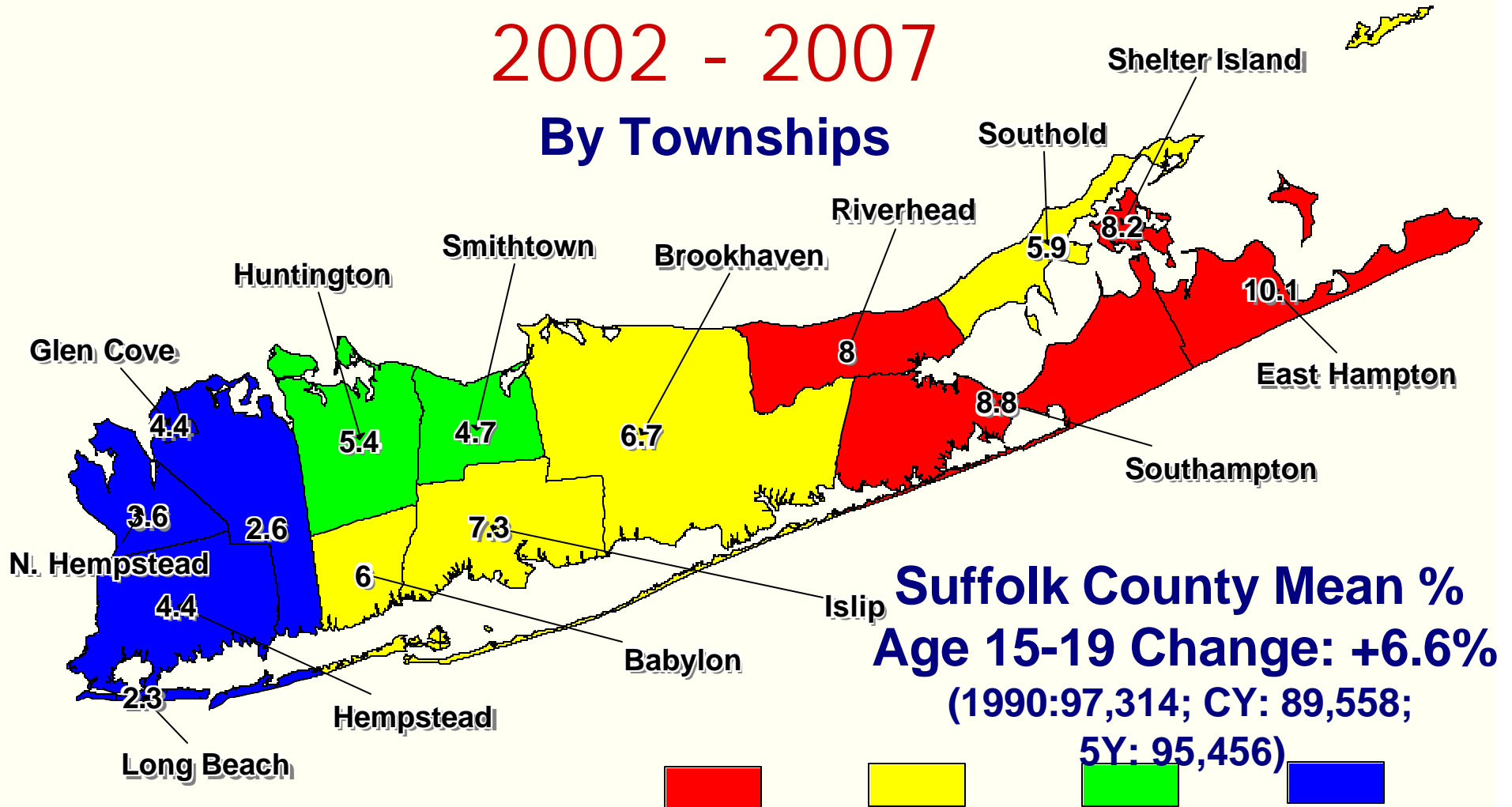

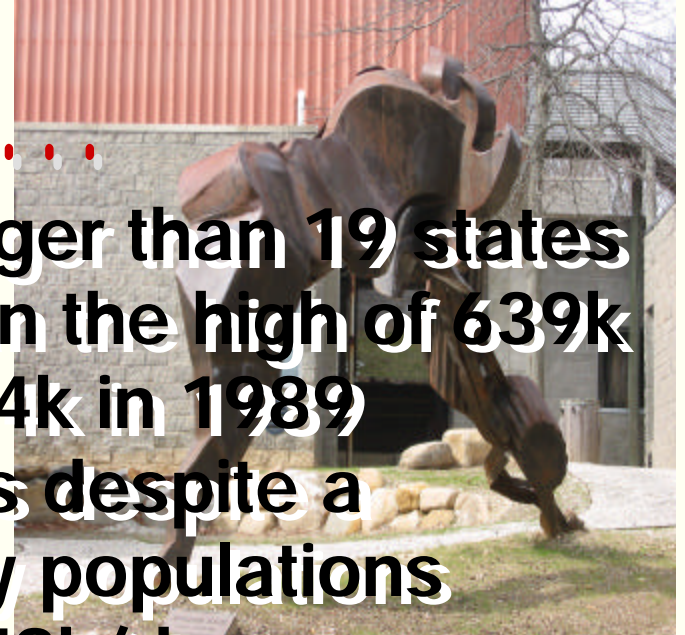

Final LI Factoids...

- 2 Long Island's Population is bigger than 19 states
- 2 School population is lower than the high of 639k in 1972 but higher than the 384k in 1989
- 2 LI has the same 13 poor towns despite a substantial increase in minority populations
- 2 Commuter to NYC steady at 279k/day; commuters to LI jumped from 64k to 105k
- 2 25% of all LI housing outpaced family income
- 2 2 counties, 13 towns, 2 cities, 95 villages, 126 school districts, 2 Indian reservations and 776 other taxing districts from fire and library to garbage
